## TRAMWAY AND LIGHT RAILWAY UNDERTAKINGS.

## INTRODUCTORY

The particulars given in the following tables relate to work of construction. repair, etc., carried out by employees of Tramway and Light Railway Undertakings, and by Companies and Local Authorities operating trackless trolley vehicle services. Work carried out by private firms on behalf of Tramway and light Railway Gompanies is deait with in the reports on the vatious trades concerned with the work.
In comparing the general summary particulars (Table I A) for 1935 with those shown for 1930, the effect of any transference of services previously operated by companies to road transport authorities, such as the London Passenger Transport Board, should be borne in mind.
