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## wholesale bottling trade

THIS REPORT on the Wholesale Bottling Trade relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in the wholesale bottling of beer, wines, spirits, mineral waters, etc.. (but not milk, fo which see the Milk Products Trade). Separate bottling establishments maintained by brewers and
distillers, and whisky blenders who are not distillers are included.

Some brewing firms that maintained bottling establishments were unable to furnish separate returns for the latter and, therefore, included their bottling departments in the general returns for the breweries

For the year 1950. Census of Production returns were required, in Great Britain, only from establishments that sold no merchanted goods nor undertook retailing during the year; other establishments (i.e.. those which engaged in merchanting or retailing as well as production) made Information for 1950 comparable this trade is, therefore, not available

This trade corresponds to minimum list heading $1 \hat{\omega} 4$ in the Standard Industrial Classification.
