## 76 Electronic computers

This Report on the Electronic Computer Industry relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in manufacturing digital, analogue and hybrid electronic computers and related equipment, including peripheral equipment for computing systems and data transmission equipment. Telecommunication links, and computers and peripheral equipment not separable from industrial control systems are excluded.

This industry corresponds to minimum list heading 366 in the Standard Industrial Classification (Revised 1968) which has been used for the first time as a basis of classification in the 1968 Census.

The industry formed part of the Radio and 0ther Electronic Apparatus Industry (Part 58) in the last detailed Census of Production for 1963.

Throughout this Report, the figures given for 1963 have been reclassified, as far as possible, according to the Standard Industrial Classification (Revised 1968) so that data for 1963 and 1968 are on the same industrial basis. However the reclassification of small firms, which provided limited information only, has been arbitrary.

In interpreting the data in the tables it is essential to bear in mind the notes and definitions which appear on pages (i) to (iv).
