## THE BUTTER, CHEESE, CONDENSED MILK AND MARGARINE TRADES

### INTRODUCTORY

These trades comprise factories and creameries at which the principal business carried on was the manufacture of butter, cheese, condensed milk, milk powder and other milk products, and margarine. Dairies chiefly engaged in the distribution of milk are excluded, but particulars of the output at some of these establishments were obtained and are given in Table V B. Production on farms is excluded throughout.

The 1935 particulars cover the departments of certain firms engaged in the production of condensed milk for use in their own works; such departmental returns were not furnished in respect of the earlier years and the figures for these years are not, therefore, strictly comparable with the 1935 aggregates.
