ENTERPRISE ANALYSES

The Summary Tables of the Report on the Census of Production for 1958 bring together and analyse some of the information collected in the Census of Production for 1958. Comparisons are given wherever possible with 1954 - the year for which the last detailed census of production was taken. Comparisons of the results of the detailed Census for 1954 with those taken for 1948 and 1951 may be found in the Reports of the Census of Production for 1954.

These Summary Tables are published in three separate parts. The first (Part 133) provides summaries of the principal aggregates given in the reports on individual industries, together with some further analyses; the second (Part 134) contains regional and country tables; the third (Part 135) contains an analysis in terms of enterprises and shows, inter alia, the contribution the largest industrial enterprises make to industrial output as a whole, and the industries in which they are engaged.

ENTERPRISE ANALYSES

- 1. The summary tables in this report (Part 135) relate to enterprises, and all of them except Table 12 relate to enterprises in the private sector employing 100 or more persons (described as 'larger enterprises'). The term enterprise means one or more firms under common ownership or control as defined in the Companies Act, 1948, and an enterprise normally consists either of a single firm, or of a holding company together with its subsidiary companies. The enterprise analyses here presented entailed bringing together all the returns for the 1958 Census of Production for each enterprise that made more than one return, and classifying the enterprise as a whole to the industry group in which it had the largest net output. Enterprises that made only one return are also included in the analyses but for them no further classification was required.
- 2. To maximize the amount of information that could be published without the risk of disclosing information relating to individual enterprises, and to make the size of the tables more manageable, the 130 census industries have been combined into 57 industry groups, which are defined in the Appendix in terms of the Standard Industrial Classification.
- 3. The Census of Production for 1958 did not include a direct inquiry into links of ownership between companies. Information about the constituent companies of enterprises was mainly obtained from published sources, such as the Stock Exchange Year Book, supplemented by information derived from company reports, or from correspondence with firms. The information is not absolutely complete, but covers the largest and most important groups of industrial firms, and is believed sufficient to provide a worthwhile basis for analysis.
- 4. Though enterprises are defined here in exactly the same way as in previous Parts of the Report on the Census of Production for 1958, the present analysis differs in that it relates to the whole of an enterprise's activities within the field covered by the census, whatever the industries in which it was engaged. All the figures for enterprises published earlier have related to the activities of an enterprise within one or other of the 130 industries distinguished in the census.
- 5. The census covers public as well as private industrial undertakings, but the analyses in the following tables mainly relate to enterprises in the private sector. Government Departments, local authorities and public corporations have been excluded, except for the iron and steel companies whose shares in 1958 were held by the Iron and Steel Holding and Realisation Agency.

These publicly owned iron and steel companies have been treated as separate enterprises, not as a single enterprise.

- 6. Coal mining, Gas, Electricity, Water supply and Textile converting have been excluded, apart from the total shown for the public sector in Table 12.
- TABLE 12. ANALYSIS BY TOTAL EMPLOYMENT SIZE, 1958
 7. This table gives estimates of total employment, net output and capital expenditure for all enterprises in the private sector analysed by the size of their total employment (in all industry groups).
- 8. Totals are shown for the private sector as a whole, for the public sector as a whole and for all enterprises, the latter agreeing with the corresponding totals shown for all industries in Tables 1 and 3 (Part 133).
- 9. Sub-totals are shown for enterprises in the private sector employing 100 persons or more, and the subsequent analyses (Tables 13 to 19) relate to these larger enterprises only.
- TABLE 13. ANALYSIS BY SIZE OF NET OUTPUT, 1958 10. This table shows total employment, net output and capital expenditure for larger enterprises in the private sector analysed by the size of their total net output.
- TABLE 14. ANALYSIS BY TOTAL EMPLOYMENT SIZE AND MAIN INDUSTRY GROUP, 1958
- 11. This table shows total employment and net output for larger enterprises in the private sector classified by main industry group and by four employment size groups. The employment size groups are for enterprises with a total employment (in all industry groups) of 5,000 or more persons; 1,000 to 4,999 persons; 500 to 999 persons; and 100 to 499 persons.
- TABLE 15. ANALYSIS BY MAIN INDUSTRY GROUP SHOWING ACTIVITIES IN OTHER INDUSTRY GROUPS, 1958 12. The purpose of this table is to show the extent to which enterprises specialised in their main industry group and the extent and direction of diversification.
- 13. Table 15 shows total employment and net output for larger enterprises in the private sector classified by main industry group, and how total employment and net output were distributed between establishments in the main industry group and establishments in other industry groups. The extent of specialisation in each industry group is shown by an index which measures the net output of the enterprises at establishments in their main industry group as a percentage of their total net output.

- 14. Within each industry group separate figures are shown for enterprises wholly engaged in their main industry group and for enterprises with establishments in other census industry groups. The names of the other groups are specified for all industry groups within manufacturing industry in which 500 or more persons were employed, the remainder being accounted for in a composite heading (with the number of groups shown in brackets).
- 15. In order to avoid the risk of disclosing information relating to individual enterprises, in many cases particulars of the employment and net output in establishments outside the main industry group have had to be withheld. The names of other industry groups however provide an indication of the principal inter-connections between industry groups.
- TABLE 16. ANALYSIS BY INDUSTRY GROUP OF CAPITAL EXPENDITURE, 1958
- 16. This table shows capital expenditure in 1958 for larger enterprises in the private sector classified by main industry group, and how the total was distributed between establishments in the main industry group and establishments in other industry groups.
- 17. Within each industry group separate figures are shown for enterprises wholly engaged in their main industry group and for enterprises with establishments in other industry groups. The names of the other groups are specified for all industry groups within manufacturing industry on which they spent £100,000 or more, the remainder on which there was any expenditure in 1958 being shown in a composite heading (with the number of groups indicated in brackets).
- 18. In order to avoid the risk of disclosing information relating to individual enterprises, in many cases particulars of capital expenditure in 1958 on establishments outside the main industry group have had to be withheld.
- 19. The figures for 'Capital expenditure less disposals' comprise capital expenditure on new building work and on plant, machinery and vehicles (including that incurred for establishments not yet in production), less amounts received for plant, machinery and vehicles disposed of.
- TABLE 17. ANALYSIS OF ESTABLISHMENTS BY INDUSTRY GROUP SHOWING THE MAIN INDUSTRY GROUP OF THE ENTERPRISE TO WHICH THEY BELONGED, 1958
- 20. This table differs from the others in this report (Part 135) in that it primarily relates to establishments. The other tables analyse in various ways 10,843 larger enterprises in the private sector and show, inter alia, that they owned 24,469 establishments. Table 17 shows total employment and net output for these 24,469 establishments classified by industry group.

- 14. Within each industry group separate figures are shown for enterprises wholly engaged in their main industry group and for enterprises with establishments in other census industry groups.

 21. The sum of the numbers of enterprises shown for the various industry groups exceeds the total for all industries to the extent that enterprises had establishments in more than one industry group.
 - 22. Table 17 also analyses the establishments in each industry group by the main industry group of the enterprise to which they belonged, distinguishing between establishments:
 - (i) of enterprises wholly in the same
 industry group;
 - (ii) of enterprises mainly but not wholly in the same industry group; and
 - (iii) of enterprises mainly in other industry groups.
 - The names of the other groups are specified for all industry groups within manufacturing industry with establishments employing 500 or more persons, the others being accounted for in a composite heading (with the number of groups shown in brackets).
 - 23. In effect Table 17 presents a re-arrangement of the basic data in Table 15, the analysis in Table 17 being by the industry group of the establishment and the analysis in Table 15 by the main industry group of the enterprise.
 - TABLE 18. ANALYSIS BY MAIN INDUSTRY GROUP AND TOTAL EMPLOYMENT SIZE SHOWING PERCENTAGE OF NET OUTPUT IN MAIN INDUSTRY GROUP, 1958
 - 24. This table like Table 15 shows total employment and net output for larger enterprises in the private sector classified by main industry group, and similarly shows the extent of specialisation in each industry group by an index which measures the net output of the enterprises at establishments in their main industry group as a percentage of their total net output.
 - 25. Table 18 also shows how total employment and net output for the enterprises in each industry group were distributed between enterprises with different percentages of specialisation, four separate categories being distinguished, viz., 100 per cent. (i.e. wholly engaged in one main industry group); 75 per cent. but under 100 per cent.; 50 per cent. but under 75 per cent.; and less than 50 per cent. specilisation.
 - 26. A further analysis is made by total employment size, four employment size groups being distinguished, viz., 5,000 persons or more; 1,000 to 4,999; 500 to 999; and 100 to 499.
 - TABLE 19. ANALYSIS BY TOTAL EMPLOYMENT SIZE SHOWING NUMBER OF INDUSTRY GROUPS IN WHICH ENGAGED, 1958
 - 27. This table shows total employment and net output for larger enterprises in the private sector cross-analysed by employment size and the number of different industry groups in which they had establishments. The employment size groups are the same as in Table 18.
