## GLUE, GUM, PASTE AND ALLIED TRADES

THIS REPORT on the Glue, Gum, Paste and Allied Trades relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in the manufacture of gelatine, glue, gum, paste, shellac, size, etc., including preliminary processes such as scraping, crushing of bones, and sorting and grinding of gums.

These trades correspond to minimum list heading 39 (4) in the Standard Industrial Classification.

Any establishments in Northern Ireland are excluded in 1948; production was recorded there in these trades for 1937 or 1935.
