## 81 Wheeled tractor manufacturing

This Report on the Wheeled Tractor Manufacturing Industry relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in manufacturing and assembling three and four wheeled and half-tracked tractors; manufacturing parts and accessories (other than rough or semi-finished castings and forgings) when made wholly or primarily of metal and not reparted elsewhere. Industrial tractors, crawler tractors, road tractors solely for tractor-trailer combinations and electrical accessories and other electriqal equipment are excluded.

This industry corresponds to minimum list heading 380 in the Standard Industrial Classification (Revised 1968) which has been used for the first time as a basis of classification in the 1968 Census.

The Industry formed part of the Motor Vehicle Manufacturing Industry (Part 62) in the last detailed Census of Production for 1963 except for gears and gear wheels which were included in the report for the General Mechanical Engineering Industry (Part 52).

Throughout this Report, the figures given for 1963 have been reclassified, as far as possible, according to the Standard Industrial Classification (Revised 1968) so that data for 1963 and 1968 are on the same industrial basis. However the reclassification of small firms, which provided limited information only, has been arbitrary.

In interpreting the data in the tables it is essential to bear in mind the notes and definitions which appear on pages (i) to (iv).
