OCCUPATIONS IN THE PRINCIPAL TOWNS AND THEIR SUBURBS.

The classification of the occupations of the people is one of the most involved operations undertaken in connection with a population census. Of the primary data required the following are the most important:

- (1) The personal occupation
- (2) The industry in which that personal occupation is carried out, e.g. carpenter in the building trade, or in the mining industry or in ship-building, etc; electrician in municipal service, or in the engineering, or in the building trade, etc.
- (3) The status which the individual holds in relation to occupation, e.g. independent worker, proprietor, wage-labourer, etc.
- (4) The status which the individual holds in relation to the industry, e.g. manager, foreman, working journeyman, clerk, etc.

Given these primary data it is further possible to throw light on various social aspects of the population and industrial problems of the country by relating the information to other details given in the census form about the individual, e.g. his age, his country of birth, his racial origin or his religion.

The preparation and careful scrutiny of all this information demands time, especially as practically all other details of the Census have to be worked out before the tables referred to in the preceding paragraph can be prepared.

In view, however, of the urgent need for more up to date information about occupations, than is available from the Census of 1921, it has been decided to publish the tables contained in the report in advance of the complete information, which will not be available for some time to come.

The tables give the main occupations in the larger urban areas. Details of occupations involving only few workers have been omitted. As it is necessary to limit the size of this Report only a few specially selected occupations of females are given.

A further report on "Industries" is in course of preparation.

BEROEPE IN DIE VERNAAMSTE STEDEN EN HULLE VOORSTEDEN

Die klassifikasie van die beroepe van die bevolking is een van die mees-ingewikkelde werkzaamhede wat in verband met 'n volkstelling onderneem word. Onder die eerste gegewens wat vereis word, is die volgende die moes-belaangrike:

- (1) Die persoonlike beroep
- (2) Die nywerheid waarin daardie persoonlike beroep uitgevoer word, d.i. timmerman in die bouvak, of in die myn-industrie of in skeepsbou, ens.; elektrisiën in munisipale diens, of in die werktuigkundc, of in die bouvak, ens.
- (3) Die status van die enkeling met betrekking tot die bedryf, d.i. afsonderlike werker, eienaar, loontrekker-arbeider, ens.
- (4) Die status van die enkeling met betrekking tot die nywerheid, d.i. bestuurder, voorman, werkende opsigter, klerk, ens.

Met hierdie eerste gegewens is dit verder moontlik om op verskillende sosiale toestande van die bevolking en nywerheidsvraagstukke van die land die lig te woordeur die informasie in verband te bring met ander besonderhede omtrent die enkeling op die sensusvorm gegee, d.i. sy leeftyd, sy geborenteland, sy afkoma of sy godsdiens.

Die uitsoek en sorgvuldige nagaan van al hierdie informasie vra tyd, veral aangesien nagenoeg alle ander besonderhede van die sensusvorm uitgewerk moet word alvorens die in die voorafgaande paragraaf bedoelde tabelle saamgestel kan word.

Met die oog egter op die dringende eis vir meer vertroubare informasie omtrent beroepe dan verkry is van die Sensus van 1921, is besluit om voorlopig die tabelle van die verslag alvas te publiseer, aangesien volledige informasie eers later beskikbaar sal wees.

Die tabelle gee die vernaamste beroepe in die groter stadsentrumme. Gegevens van beroepe waarin slechts weinig werkers betrokke is, is buite rekening gelaat. Aangesien dit nodig is om hierdie verslag binne sekere grense te hou, word slegs 'n paar spesiaal-uitgesogte beroepe van vrye gegee.
