Part XI.—Buildings and Dwellings.

394. The instructions given on the Householders' Schedules for the assistance of persons recording information as to the nature of their places of habitation were as follows:—

“State whether the outer walls are built of Stone, Brick, Wood, Concrete, Iron, Canvas, or what other materials. Also state number of Rooms, including Kitchen, and exclusive of Shop, Office, Store, Bathroom, or Pantry.”

395. From the Returns submitted a record was made of 268,704 Dwellings throughout the Colony, irrespective of Race or Nationality of the occupants. Classifying these under the Race Heads to which they belong, judged by the Nationality of the Householder, we find the distribution is as follows:—

396. In turning to the Tables from which we obtain the above result (Part XI), we observe that information concerning Dwellings is given in detail for every Magisterial Division or Centre under the various Race Heads. Also, that information concerning the Dwellings of Europeans or Whites is given on one Table, separate Tables being used for “Indians and Asiatics,” “Mixed and Others,” and “Natives.”

397. Taking the first three Races, and omitting the Native Huts and Dwellings, we obtain the following results:—

400. Omitting the Native Huts, which, in point of numbers, supersede any other class of Dwelling, we note that those Houses built of Brick and "Wood-and-Iron" are much in excess of any other.

401. But, as a comparison, which includes the Dwellings of all Nationalities, White or Black, is rather vague, we now submit a Summary, which will show the number of each kind of Dwelling for each Race separately. The number of Stone Houses occupied by Europeans in relation to the total number of houses occupied by Europeans only, and so on with the whole.

402. From the above it is apparent that the Dwellings of the people, particularly those of the European Races, are of a substantial character. For the Europeans, the principal material used in construction is Brick, the same applying to the Mixed Races, whilst for the Indians it is apparent that Wood-and-Iron (for economic reasons), predominate.

403. This Table supplements in detail the information contained in the preceding Table No. 1, and from the figures given we arrive at the following:—

404. The main features of these Tables, with reference to Materials of which Dwellings are built, etc., have been already dealt with in a previous Summary in these remarks.

405. This Table has been prepared to show the number of Houses or Dwellings in the Colony in conjunction with the accommodation of each. Thus we have presented figures shewing the number of Dwellings with one Room, the number with two Rooms, and so with the remainder. Native Huts and Dwellings are not included, but are shown on a separate Table.

406. Taking the total number of Dwellings in occupation at the time of the Census, we find that for the Colony the following results were obtained:—

407. From the above it is evident that the Dwellings with from 3 to 6 rooms are most general throughout the Colony.

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Part XII.—Convicts and Prisoners.

408. Information concerning the "Convicts and Prisoners" was obtained through the medium of special Prisoners' Forms, supplied to every Gaol and Lock-up throughout the Colony and on these Forms all Persons *under detention* on the Census Day were recorded by the authorities in charge, with the nature of the Crime brought against them. In the case of Prisoners who had not yet been sentenced, they were shown as "Awaiting Trial."

409. Warders and other Gaol Officials were recorded separately, on the Householders' Forms, so that a distinction was made between them and Prisoners.

410. From these Returns a record was given of 2,504 Prisoners of all Nationalities.

Classifying them under the various Races, we obtain the following results:—
