## AREA MORTALITY 1969-73

### 1.1 Introduction

Since 1837 the Registrar General's Annual Reports<sup>1</sup> have contained tables of mortality statistics by area. More detailed analyses of area data aggregated over a ten-year period were included in decennial supplements and the first such supplement, to the 25th Annual Report, covered the years 1851 to 1860. Prior to that, the 9th Annual Report had included tables of deaths and death rates by area computed from deaths registered in the seven years 1838-44 and from populations enumerated at the 1841 Census; and the 16th Annual Report had contained tables based on deaths in the ten years 1841-50.

The coverage by decennial supplements of deaths in the inter-censal ten-year periods continued in this fashion until the decade of 1921-30, and included mortality by area as part of a comprehensive review of the decade. After the Second World War, the period covered was changed to circum-censal and the decennial supplements on area mortality were published as separate volumes. The first covered deaths in the four years 1950-53 and used the 1951 Census populations. The next volume was based on the five-year period 1959-63 and the 1961 Census.

The present volume continues this series with an analysis based on deaths registered in the five years 1969-73 and populations enumerated at the 1971 Census. It differs from its predecessors in that all tables are published on microfiche. This has enabled OPCS to include more extensive tabulations. The contents of the microfiche are described in Section 7.

Some tables of mortality by area for the period 1970-72 have already been published as part of the decennial supplement on occupational mortality.<sup>2</sup> These tables show deaths and standardised mortality ratios (SMRs) by social class and occupation order in standard regions, hospital regions and density aggregates, for a few selected causes.

## 1.2 Area definitions

### 1.2.1 Area units and geographical division of England and Wales

The areas are those which existed before reorganisation 1 April 1974

The new areas differ considerably from the old. In particular, the urban/rural distinction has ceased to be identifiable so that this volume is the last in which area mortality may be analysed in this way.

The primary units of geographical division of England and Wales, which have been used for the analysis of mortality data, are the areas administered by local authorities. These areas were defined by the Local Government Acts as county boroughs (CBs), London boroughs (LBs), municipal boroughs (MBs), urban districts (UDs) and rural districts (RDs).

A number of local authority areas together formed a county. The London boroughs, together with the City of London formed the area administered by the Greater London Council, which was treated as the county of Greater London. There were 46 counties in England (including Greater London) and 13 in Wales during the period covered by the analysis.

Standard regions were formed by combining whole counties, with the exception of Derbyshire and Dorset, parts of which were allocated to different regions. There were eight regions in England and two in Wales. In the regional analyses, data are given for Wales as a whole, in addition to the two regions separately.

Independently of standard regions, England and Wales was also divided into 15 hospital regions each consisting of several complete local authority areas. These coincided with the areas administered by the regional hospital boards, except where boundaries of the latter divided local authority areas. Any such divided local authority area was allocated to the hospital region containing the greatest proportion of the population of the local authority area.

**1.2.2 Conurbations and density aggregates** Large centres of population were designated as conurbations for the presentation of official statistics generally. There were six such conurbations including Greater London during the period covered by the analysis. Each comprised a number of complete local authority areas.

The statistics of local authority areas of England and Wales were aggregated into five groups, referred to as density aggregates, comprising:

- a. the six conurbations combined,
- b. urban areas (that is CBs, MBs and UDs) outside conurbations with populations of 100,000 and over,
- c. urban areas outside the conurbations with populations of 50,000 and under 100,000,
- d. urban areas outside conurbations with populations under 50,000, and
- e. rural districts outside conurbations.

The resident population at the 1971 Census was used as the basis at b, c and d.

**1.2.3 Other area groups used in the tables** Data are given for each region as a whole and further divided into aggregates of urban areas and rural areas. If the region contained a conurbation, (or two as in the case of North West Region), the conurbation is shown and the urban/rural aggregates are of local authorities outside the conurbation. The urban areas are CBs, MBs and UDs. The urban and rural aggregates are given for Wales as a whole, but not for each of the two regions of Wales. Urban and rural aggregates for the South East Region outside the Greater London conurbation are shown separately for an area defined as the Outer Metropolitan area and for the remainder of the South East Region. Although the counties included CBs, administratively these were independent of the county authorities. The administrative county (AC) comprised only the MBs, the UDs and the RDs within the county. Figures are given for the county, with a sub-total for all CBs in the county, for individual CBs and for the administrative county separately. In addition aggregates of urban and rural areas within a county are also shown; in this context the urban aggregates comprised only MBs and UDs. The administrative county (AC) and the geographical county were the same if there were no CBs in the county.

**1.2.4 Composition and lists of areas** The composition of regions, conurbations, hospital regions and the Outer Metropolitan area is shown in Appendix A. All areas for which tabulations are provided are shown in Appendix B and listed on pages 15 to 27 together with their populations by age and sex (Table OA for males and Table OB for females).

## 1.3 Deaths

Deaths included in the analyses are those which were registered in England and Wales during the five-year period 1969-73, of both civilians and non-civilians. They have been assigned to the area of usual residence of the deceased if this was in England and Wales; otherwise they have been assigned to the area in which the death occurred.

Accommodation provided under Parts III and IV of the National Assistance Act, 1948 (for example, homes for epileptics, blind people and so on), is regarded as the place of usual residence of persons dying there. Both chronic sick and psychiatric hospitals were treated as the place of residence of the deceased if the person had been resident in such a hospital for six months preceding death. In all other instances of deaths in institutions the death was assigned to the area of previous usual residence.

Where deaths of persons usually resident in England and Wales occurred abroad, these were not included in the analysis. Although such deaths may be noted by this Office for death certification purposes, they are not included in regular mortality tables. To conform with this procedure for deaths, the census populations used here were obtained, as described in Section 4, by excluding persons outside England and Wales on the night of the census.

It should be noted that since 1972, deaths of visitors have been coded to the country of residence of the deceased. For this analysis however, deaths registered in 1972 and 1973 were recoded to the area of occurrence of death in line with the practice of the previous three years. Consequently, figures in this analysis do not agree with the totals of those published in the annual volumes of 1969-73.

#### 1.4 Populations

The population of areas described in Section 2 have been derived from those enumerated in England and Wales at the 1971 Census. Persons enumerated at the census as resident in England and Wales were assigned to the area of their usual residence, irrespective of the place of their enumeration in England and Wales. Visitors, that is persons usually resident outside England and Wales, were assigned to the area in which they were enumerated.

Usual residence of persons enumerated in certain non-private establishments was determined by specific rules. As described in Section 3, Part III and Part IV accommodation was treated as the usual residence of the inmates, while patients enumerated in chronic sick and psychiatric hospitals were treated as residents only if they had been there for six months or more. Patients in other hospitals and students away from home during term time were instructed to give their home address as their usual address. Persons who did not state a usual address were allocated to their area of enumeration.

It should be noted that the populations of areas computed as above and used for the calculation of rates and SMRs differ marginally from those shown in published census tables. Census tables show either the enumerated population of an area, or the resident population (obtained by reallocating enumerated populations by usual residence, including the transfer, where appropriate, of persons enumerated in Scotland to areas in England and Wales or vice versa). For area mortality calculations, persons enumerated in Scotland were ignored; persons resident in Scotland but enumerated in England and Wales were treated as visitors and thus assigned to their area of enumeration.

#### 1.5 Causes of death

The International Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of death (ICD) 1965 (Eighth Revision) is used. Where more than one cause of death is mentioned on the medical certificate, the underlying cause is determined in accordance with the international procedure. The ICD provides for grouping of the causes into 3 and 4-digit categories and aggregation of these into Chapters, Abridged Lists, and so on. Appendix C lists a selection of such categories included in the tables.

#### 1.6 Death rates and standardised mortality ratios (SMRs)

With the exception of infant mortality (deaths under one year of age) the sex/age specific death rates for areas have been calculated as the mean annual deaths in 1969-73 per million persons in the relevant sex and age-group enumerated at the 1971 Census and assigned to the areas as described in Section 4. For deaths under one year the sex specific rates are calculated as deaths in 1969-73 per million live births occurring in the same period.

Standardised mortality ratios (SMRs) express the registered number of deaths (at stated ages) as a percentage of the number of deaths that would be expected in the area if the death rates for each age-group had been the same as that of England and Wales. For each sex, two types of SMR are shown in the tables; those calculated at all ages and those calculated at ages 15-64. The age-groups used for this purpose are 0-4, 5-14, 15-24, 25-34, 35-44, 45-54, 55-64, 65-74 and 75 and over. Although deaths are shown in the tables separately for the age-groups 75-84 and 85 and over, populations on an area basis were available only for the 75 and over age-group as a whole.

**1.7.2 Sex** Deaths in each table are presented in two parts - part A for males and part B for females. Populations are shown in Table OA for males and Table OB for females. Live births by sex are shown in Table OC.

##### 1.7.3 Age-groups

- a. In Tables 1, 2 and 4, ten-year groups are used for ages 5 to 84; the remaining age-groups are shown as 0, 1-4 and 85 and over.
- b. Populations are given in Tables OA and OB for ten-year age-groups from age 5 to 74 only, with one group for all aged 75 and over. As above, 0 and 1-4 age-groups are used below 5 years.
- c. The abridged age-groups in Table 3 are: 0, 1-4, 15-64, 65-74 and 75 and over.

**1.7.4 Cause of death** The main table is number 2, which gives deaths and SMRs for all the areas in Appendix B and all the causes in Appendix C. The main axis is cause, with all the areas listed under each cause. On the microfiche, each cause is shown in one column, the areas covering all 12 frames (pages of a table) of the column.

**1.7.5 Area** In Tables 1 and 4, area is used as the main axis. For each area, all the causes are presented together, on three frames. Causes shown in italics in Appendix C are not included. Areas at regional level, that is those in Appendix B part 1, are included in Table 1 and areas at county level, shown in Appendix B part 2, are included in Table 4.

**1.7.6 Death rates** Table 3 gives numbers of deaths and rates in broad age-groups for the same causes and areas as Table 2. The order of presentation of the two tables is identical.

**1.7.7 Other local authority areas** Individual local authority areas, other than CBSs, are not included in Appendix B. Data for each of these will be available on microfiche as unpublished tables, in the format of Table 2. The microfiche are obtainable from Information Branch (Dept AM), Office of Population Censuses and Surveys, St Catherines House, 10 Kingsway, London WC2B 6JP. Urban areas, that is MBs and UDs, are tabulated together as the urban supplement, and the rural districts are tabulated as the rural supplement. These supplement tables can be obtained from Medical Statistics Division, Office of Population Censuses and Surveys, St Catherines House, 10 Kingsway, London WC2B 6JP.

**1.7.8 Populations** Populations by age are shown in Tables OA and OB for the areas in Appendix B.

**1.7.9 Births** Male and female live births in the period 1969-73 are shown in Table OC.

**1.7.10 How to use the microfiche** The fiche on which each table appears are shown in the summary of tables.

If a number of causes are required for a particular area, Table 1 or 4 should be used. The location of each area on the fiche is given in Appendix B parts 1 and 2 respectively for these tables. An example of data in these tables for an area is shown on page 60.

When data for a single cause are required for a number of areas, Tables 2 or 3 should be used. The column relating to each cause on the fiche is shown in Appendix C. An area on Tables 2 or 3 always appears in the same position in each column of the fiche. The order in which the areas appear can be found by reference to Table OA on pages 30 to 53 in this booklet. The letter in the top righthand corner of each page of Table O corresponds to the row on the fiche relating to Tables 2 and 3 in which the relevant area is shown. If cancer of the bladder (ICD 188) data for Ealing LB are required, for example, then reference to Appendix C will show that cancer of the bladder appears on fiche number 4 in column 1. Each page of Table OA has a letter in the top righthand corner which equates with a lettered row on the fiche. Reference to the page for Ealing LB (see page 34) shows this letter as "F". This indicates that Ealing LB can always be found on row F of a fiche in Tables 2 and 3. Therefore row F of fiche number 4 column 1 will give the required data. It should be noted that the column number and row letter appear below the relevant frame on the fiche. Example frames from Tables 2A and 3A are shown on pages 63 and 64 respectively.
