CENSUS OF POPULATION, 5th MAY, 1936.

PRELIMINARY REPORT.

A census of the population of the Union of South Africa was taken on the night of 5th/6th May, 1936, in accordance with Proclamation No. 234 of the 5th November, 1935, made by His Honour the Officer Administering the Government under the Census Act, No. 2 of 1910.

Concurrently with the enumeration in the Union, censuses were taken in the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, the High Commission Territories of Basutoland, Swaziland, and Bechuanaland Protectorate; and also in Southern Rhodesia.

The first preliminary results of the Union Census, taken from roughly checked results in Enumerators' Summary Books, were available on the 15th June, less than six weeks after the Enumerators started on their itineraries. They were published in the *Union Government Gazette* of the 19th June.

The present publication is a revision of the results of the preliminary audit and shows the following increases:—

The differences are mainly due to the late receipt of forms and books from many areas; and to errors in summation by enumerators. It was also found that many books and forms had not been included in the original summaries compiled by enumerators. After publication of the preliminary returns from supervisors, it was discovered that the figures relative to the Natives on one of the gold mines in Johannesburg had not been received.

The final results, which will be arrived at by machine tabulation, will be available about the middle of 1937, but it is not anticipated that they will vary to any appreciable extent from those now published. The principal difference will probably be due to adjustments between the European and Coloured community, between Bantu and Coloured, and to a lesser degree between males and females, according to the degree of care exercised by enumerators in compiling their summaries.

**British South Africa.**—The preliminary results of the censuses in the other territories of South Africa, available at the time of going to press were as given hereunder:—

**Historical Survey.**—Table 1 gives a history of the censuses taken in the States now comprising the Union since the first enumeration in the Cape of Good Hope in 1865. Since that date, the area has increased by the following additions:—

- Between Censuses of 1865 and 1875, British Kaffraria was annexed to the old Cape Colony;
- Between Censuses of 1875 and 1891, Griqualand West, and the Transkeian Native Territories (excluding Pondoland) were annexed to Cape Colony;
- Between Censuses of 1891 and 1904, Pondoland and the area known as British Bechuanaland were added to Cape Colony.

The first simultaneous census of the area now comprising the Union was taken on the 17th April, 1904, while the first census of the Union was taken on the 7th May, 1911.

**Organization of the Census.**—The following table gives some idea of the field organization for the purpose of the enumeration.

The unit of supervision is the magisterial district and, with certain exceptions, the Magistrate is the Supervisor of Census for his area. Excluding Supervisors and special clerical assistants there were 11,524 persons employed on active enumeration.

The Union was divided up into 8,445 sub-districts, 2,836 for the towns and villages, and 5,609 sub-divisions of the Native Reserves, Crown lands, farming areas, etc.

The persons engaged in field work numbered 7,797 European and 534 non-European Enumerators. In addition, 822 non-European interpreters and 2,371 Native chiefs and headmen were employed to ensure that the non-European elements of the populations were accounted for. An analysis of the 8,331 Enumerators shows that 191 were railway officials for the enumeration of passengers on trains and at stations, and of officials in restrooms, 495 were police officers, 1,607 were Government officials, 5,504 were farmers and other private individuals and 534 were non-Europeans.
