## Did you know that

- \*The Treaty of Rome envisages integrated foreign and defence policies for the countries of the EEC?
- \*Sweden is considered ineligible for membership because of its neutralist foreign policy?
- \*In October 1973 a NATO committee recommended a unified Western European nuclear force to help in the fight against communism?
- \*Most European countries are not and do not intend becoming members of the EEC?

The Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament (CND) is in favour of greater European unity and cooperation. We would like to see trade and cooperation embracing the present NATO, Warsaw Pact and neutral European countries.

The trouble with the Common Market is that it brings closer together the well-armed NATO countries and thus worsens the existing division of Europe. Since its inception the EEC has been viewed by its supporters both as an economic union and as a weapon against Eastern Europe.

For the USA also this is the great strength of the EEC, and that is why the USA is so keen that Britain should stay in.

Continued membership of the EEC will prevent Britain developing an independent policy for peace and nuclear disarmament.

The danger is that the EEC will develop a nuclear force, thus emphasising the present armed camp situation in Europe.

Little Englanders or Little Europeans - they've both got it wrong. Britain must look outside itself and outside Western Europe. We must develop our relations with Eastern Europe and the Third World without being tied down by the political restrictions of the Treaty of Rome.
