Dear Miss Pitta Turberville

I ought to have written long ago to
thank you & your sister for the book on 'women & the
Church.' I have read it once, & I am bound to say
quite frankly that I was disappointed. And (as I
think you know) I have taken a warmly sympathetic
interest in the woman's movement for some 20 years.

But I will read it again, & will give you a fuller
account of my impressions, for what they are worth.

I will only say that if some of us who care about the
woman's movement are not prepared to move in the
direction which you lay down for us, our hesitation is not
based on merely due to timidity, nor based on blind
adherence to tradition.
