ask & have it now & day. They seem terrified of our
taking to protest & what we shall say when we get out
Will you send a p.c. to Miss Brackenbury saying
that the things which have arrived from Mrs
Smclair are being distributed & gratefull thanks
are tendered by Hard Labour prisoners. Send me the
Christian Commonwealth - Mrs Sad Brown says she
is well and jolly. The word does really remind
you rather of a parrot. How ever one talking at once
I'll be simply to send you a list of names. Send a
p.c. to each one saying well & jolly -

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Dearest Lilla I have managed so well to get the food through to
the prisoners that things are simply pouring in from Clements
Mr. 18 boxes of chocolate today & host of other things all of
which have been passed by the officers. So you can judge
how lenient they are with us. There is a watering woman in this
Ball or relation to the Mr. Ball - Her sister while she had been
away had given up all her papers & two detectives have taken
them today - She is to be called upon to give evidence against the
Union. She is a stupid person & has already signed the papers
without reading them. I think the Union & Mr. Marshall should
know. We can lie down where we like & stop & bed
when we like & they say that the hard labour people are
going to be allowed their own food. I am sure you can
find out from the Unitarian or Minister how James Whelan
is sentenced - and the doctors to be kind & has
given away to the prisoners saying his people are well at
least. She told him she told and said to her a wire was
sent which she was allowed to receive. Prison days are
not what they were. Please do not worry if its really
silly of you. There is no need. If I were sure the dear
children would be safe to receive me. I should not worry
at the length of the sentence - & I feel quite surprised at myself
how calmly I feel about it - I wish you had been in Holloway
just for you would know the what it is and not be so anxious
I told that stupid doctor to write to you just - I think you look
in quiet. The wrong sense. In fact myself it was rather a
joke. I am sleeping quite well now. I asked for
some Brown & white milk & told Mr. I am sleeping well
I do not require it & I do not take it. If I got to the jail
I shall get all I require don't alarm yourself. I shall have the
Commissioner the Governor the visiting Magistrate & every
body in my cell at once if I do not. I've paid a rate
