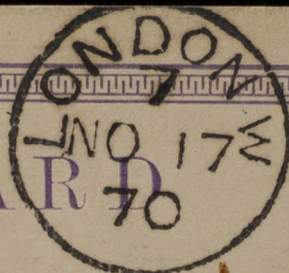
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The vestry man consent, who is by profession an undertaker, will provide -
