Dear Mr Robt,

I have read your paper on 'Women in the Priesthood' with great interest & I believe that the reasons you put forward for the objection to this idea are substantially correct. Matters like these, which are so often taken for granted, are well worth investigating, & I am glad that you are proposing to bring these less obvious considerations to the notice of those concerned - though I don't expect that your communication will meet with a very hearty reception.

In the last page or so you have rather abandoned the analytic attitude & become a little propagandist - but doubtless this is in view of the purpose of the whole discussion. It is for the same reason

perhaps that you do not go more into the general question of the Church's hostility to women. The whole Christian & Hebrew attitude is obviously permeated with the idea of woman as the cause of sin ("the woman tempted me"), male guilt being displaced or to her.

It would be interesting to compare the Christian, Hebrew & Mahommedan religions (all patriarchal male, except that the worship of the mother has crept back somewhat in the Roman Catholicism) with others in which there have been female divinities & priestesses. But this would be a big business & Goddard is clearly connected with the patriarchal v. matriarchal attitudes in society.

The possibility of women priests has probably only just become apparent, because the patriarchy has lost its power diminished so much in recent years.
