Dear Sir -

The idea of a Ladies' Political League for the North Norfolk Constituency, has for some time been under consideration.

Under the name of the Anti-Buxton League, this society has now become an organised body, with one definite aim & object, i.e. To win North Norfolk for the Unionists. Members of the League are to be divided into two classes.
