 No more companions than I  
 had - as there were only 5 & 6 cases  
 together before & now 80 I should think  
 Mr. Parshurst included. We get two  
 nurses and work together at our  
 sewing. I feel sure Barn Slipping in  
 Holloway. The Doctor said one you get  
 quite a good view from your cell. I  
 expect you will be glad to change  
 over I had in three months time. I asked  
 him twice to let me stop in Holloway &  
 he said - he thought it could be arranged  
 but quite well but I get such rheumatic  
 headaches. I wonder if you would  
 ask if I might be allowed to have a  
 bottle of Peckham water & a bottle of Budge's  
 Vanillaes such as the supplies from  
 outside. I have been accustomed to having  
 them & losing them off. I get headaches  
 the last days when he comes to my



cell to said. Are there any little  
relics comforts I can allow you  
Board No. I feel sure if you would  
& said I suffered from rheumatism  
lead a life he would be quite well if  
but we have the things of Distention  
Karellis are 2/- Same I understand  
nothing but the separation from you all  
I like it so much better than being a  
Remond prisoner. Miss George / The  
Head Officer, & very kind & gentle & any  
thing I want. Unstitch the hem of  
my clean dry dress & on the paper write a  
tiny note & sew it up again. My clothes  
get awfully dirty - shall not find notes in  
which all things there not be allowed to read  
my washing by me. I shall want another  
pair of trousers & linings from home  
Mr. Partridge says that every one outside  
ought to be able to see the sentences reduced  
on the grounds of them being monstrous  
for the offence. I told her that I had  
said it was unnecessary. It is  
a reduction of sentence. She said  
it was a mistake - a lot of good  
could be done if the complaint was  
based on these grounds - Personally I  
shall have a trouble in sticking it out.  
I shall join you all
