I fully realise the  
importance of non-militant  
Societies, but I consider  
that such societies should

confine themselves to propa-  
ganda work at by-elections,  
& should never actively aid  
a candidate of a Government  
that not only refuses us the  
vote but even declines to listen  
to our arguments. Such active  
aid is, I consider, paying  
the Government a premium  
to insult us & to continue

to ignore our cause. I enclose  
a quinea, but it is my last subscription.
