
ACT: EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN IN PUBLIC HOUSES.

Gesetz Nr. 7250 über weibliche Angestellte in Gast- und Schankwirtschaften. Vom 15. Januar 1920 (R. G. Bl. 1920, Nr. 12, S. 69).

Act respecting women employees in inns and public-houses. Dated 15th January, 1920.

Sole Section.—The central authorities of the States, or the authorities designated by them, in the interests of health and the observation of morality, order and propriety in inns and public-houses, shall issue regulations dealing in particular with the engagement, employment, and method of payment of women. The regulations shall be submitted without delay to the representatives of the people in the States in question, and shall be repealed when the said representatives shall so require.

Any person who contravenes the regulations issued under paragraph I shall be liable to imprisonment for not more than six months and a fine not exceeding 10,000 marks, or one of these penalties, or detention.
