as it remained representative)

since the Executive has become  
elective, as I am too busy to  
do more than I do.

I should not therefore have  
troubled you as to my being  
Delegate to the National Union  
of Women's Suffrage Societies,  
to which I permanently belong!



But last November, I was  
appointed a Delegate from  
the Suffrage Society to the  
National Union of Women  
Workers at Tuckbridge Wells.

This is to meet at Manchester  
in October, about the same  
time as the Council meeting  
of the Nat. U. Women's Suffrage  
Societies, & I expressed my  
desire to be again  
appointed such a Delegate,  
as I am going to Manchester  
for the Council. The only point  
on which I was uncertain  
was, whether, last year I was  
sent from the Central Society,  
or from the Nat. U. Wom. Suff. Soc.  
but I wished to express my desire  
to represent one or other of them.
