## WOOLIEN AND WORSTED TRADE

THIS REPORT on the Woollen and Worsted Trade relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in the sorting, blending, scouring and carbonising of wool and other animal hair, the recovery of wool from rags, and all intermediate processes up to and including the weaving of woollen and worsted fabrics, the manufacture of wool felt and the manufacture of wool blanket tc. The spinning of rayon, nylon, etc. staple fibre by woollen and worsted spinners is .
Establishments engaged mainly in burling and mending of woollen and worsted fabrics are included prior to 1951; for 1951 they have been excluded and are classified to the Textile Finishing Trade (Volume 6, Trade P).

This trade corresponds to minimum list heading 112 in the Standard Industrial Classification.
