

# Report on the Census of Production 1971

## C200 Provisional Results

Presented by the Department of Trade and Industry  
to Parliament in pursuance of the Statistics of Trade Act 1947  
(10 & 11 Geo. 6 Cha. 39 sec 7)

This Business Monitor presents provisional estimates of the principal results of the Census of Production for 1971, the second of the new series of annual censuses of production conducted by the Business Statistics Office (BSO). The annual censuses form part of the new integrated system of industrial statistics being introduced by the Government Statistical Service. The complete system comprises quarterly inquiries into sales of products, annual censuses, and less frequent inquiries into additional subjects, including details of purchases of goods and services by industry. The new system replaces the various short-period inquiries and the detailed censuses which have been taken at roughly five year intervals since 1907. The last detailed quinquennial census was for 1968.

The main objective of the annual censuses of production is to give the summary statistics which describe the structure of United Kingdom industry. They include a measure of net output, total sales, purchases, capital expenditure, stocks, employment and wages and salaries. The censuses make possible the comparison of the characteristics of an industry between years or with other industries in the same year.

#### Coverage

The censuses for 1970 and 1971 covered establishments in Great Britain engaged in manufacturing, mining and quarrying, electricity, gas and water supply, Orders II-XIX and XXI of the Standard Industrial Classification, revised 1968 (SIC). The Ministry of Commerce, Northern Ireland, have provided data for all industries, with the exception of mining and quarrying, and this has been incorporated in the tables which thus relate to the United Kingdom. Generally, census returns were required from establishments employing on average 25 or more persons during the census year but in industries where small firms made an important contribution to output the coverage was extended to establishments with 11 or more employees.

#### Classification

Establishments have been classified according to their major activity to industries as defined by the SIC. As details of sales are no longer collected in the censuses, establishments were classified on the basis of information supplied in the Census of Production for 1968 or in the quarterly inquiries into sales of products for those industries already covered by this part of the new system. Establishments added to the register of manufacturing businesses maintained by the BSO since the 1968 Census, which are not yet included in the quarterly production inquiries, have been classified according to the respondent's description of the business.

#### Scope

The questions asked in the censuses for 1970 and 1971 were similar to those in the 1968 Census with certain exceptions. In particular the 1970 Census returns did not ask for details of:

- a commodity detail of purchases and sales
- b payment of rates
- c payments of repairs and maintenance
- d cost of operating road goods vehicles
- or e progress payments received

The amounts payable to other organisations for transport of goods, however, did include the cost of the Post Office parcels service.

#### Response

The forms for the 1971 Census were despatched at the beginning of 1972 and reminders were sent out in April, July and August. The estimates in the tables are based on questionnaires received at the BSO up to October 12. These are estimated to cover 75 per cent of employment in manufacturing industries. The response for each industry is indicated in the tables. The response rates, however, reflect a degree of estimation because average employment of non-respondents in 1971 has itself been estimated.

#### Results

The figures in tables 1 and 2 include estimates for unsatisfactory returns, non-response and small establishments and are therefore for all establishments in each industry. Final results of the 1971 Census, including analyses by size of establishment and by region, will appear in some 150 separate industry reports which will be published in the second half of 1973. Publication of the final results for the 1970 Census begin in December 1972.

#### Comparison between 1970 and 1971

Tables 1 and 2 give comparable data for the Censuses for 1970 and 1971. The results for 1970 are also provisional and may be subject to revision in the final industry reports to be published from December 1972. Final results will be available more quickly for subsequent censuses (see preceding paragraph) and in publishing, towards the end of 1973, the provisional results for the 1972 Census comparable final results will be given for 1970 and, it is expected, for 1971.

In making any comparison with results from the 1963 and 1968 Censuses regard should be given to possible changes in reporting units between censuses.

Multi-unit businesses, that is businesses having units at more than one geographical location or in more than one industry or both, account for a greater part of economic activity than single-unit businesses. Increasingly, multi-unit businesses are unable to provide a census return for each of their individual factories and the BSO recognises that often returns must be accepted for a statistical unit which covers more than one location. Often, too, the output of these statistical units is not confined to the principal products of one industry as defined in the SIC. To the extent that a larger proportion of output was covered by these combined returns in 1970 and 1971 than in earlier years, comparisons between the data in tables 1 and 2 and that for 1963 and 1968 need to be carefully interpreted. (The problem of the statistical unit in business inquiries is fully discussed in an article by M C Fessey and H E Browning in 'Statistical News', May 1971). There is, of course, greater stability of reporting units between 1970 and 1971.

#### Definitions

Employment relates to the average number of persons employed during the year.

Gross output measures the total value of production (including work done) by establishments during the year. It is calculated as follows:

Value of sales and work done

Plus/Less: Increase/decrease in value of stocks of goods on hand for sale

Plus/Less: Increase/decrease in value of work in progress  
= Gross output

Net output represents the value added to materials by the process of production (including the margin on selling any merchanted or factored goods). It is calculated as follows:

Gross output  
Less: Purchases adjusted for change in value of stocks of fuel and raw materials  
Less: Payments for work given out to other establishments  
Less: Payments for transport  
Less: Net amount of any duties, subsidies, allowances and levies payable  
= Net output

Year of return  
Firms were asked to make returns in respect of the calendar year 1971 but a return for a business year ending on any date from April 6 1971 to April 5 1972 was accepted.

#### Rounding of figures

Figures in the tables have, where necessary, been rounded to the nearest final digit; there may, therefore, be apparent slight discrepancies between the sums of the constituent items and the totals shown.
