## Report on the Census of Production 1973

### Provisional results

This Business Monitor presents provisional estimates for the Census of Production for 1973, the fourth of the series of annual censuses of production conducted by the Business Statistics Office (BSO). The annual censuses form part of the new integrated system of industrial statistics being introduced by the Government Statistical Service. The complete system comprises quarterly inquiries into manufacturers' sales of products, annual censuses, and less frequent inquiries into additional subjects, including details of purchases of goods and services by industry. The new system replaces the various short-period inquiries and the detailed censuses which have been taken at roughly five year intervals since 1907. The last detailed quinquennial census was for 1968.

The main objective of the annual censuses of production is to give the summary statistics which describe the structure of United Kingdom industry. They include a measure of net output, total sales, purchases, capital expenditure, stocks, employment and wages and salaries. The censuses make possible the comparison of the characteristics of an industry between years or with other industries in the same year.

#### Coverage

The censuses for 1970, 1971, 1972 and 1973 covered establishments in Great Britain engaged in manufacturing, mining and quarrying, electricity, gas and water supply, Orders II-XIX and XXI of the Standard Industrial Classification, revised 1968 (SIC). The Department of Commerce, Northern Ireland, have provided data for all industries, with the exception of mining and quarrying, and this has been incorporated in the tables which thus relate to the United Kingdom. For 1973 census returns were required from establishments employing on average 20 or more persons during the year.

#### Industrial Classification

The Annual Censuses of Production are conducted on the Business Statistics Office's Production Register. Normally establishments on the register are classified to industries on the basis of major activity in conformity with the SIC; classification is generally based on an establishment's returns to the quarterly production inquiries. Where this is not possible - for example where a quarterly inquiry has not yet been introduced - the classification of an establishment reflects its return to the Census of Production, 1968, or the firm's description of its business, when responding to registration action for instance.

#### Response

The forms for the 1973 Census were despatched at the beginning of 1974 and, where necessary, three reminders were sent, the third in November. The estimates in the tables are based on questionnaires received at the BSO up to mid November. Response is estimated to cover 65 per cent of total employment, including establishments below the exemption limit of 20, in manufacturing industries. The response for each industry is indicated in Table 1. The response rates, however, reflect a degree of estimation because average employment of non-respondents in 1973 has itself been estimated.

#### Results

The figures in tables 1 and 2 include estimates for unsatisfactory returns, non-response and exempted establishments and are therefore for all establishments in each industry. Final results of the 1973 Census, including analyses by size of establishment and by region, will appear in about 160 separate industry reports which will be published from the end of 1975. Publication of the final results for the 1972 Census should begin in early January 1975. The last of the 155 industry reports for 1971 was published in November 1974. Tables 1 and 2 give data for 1970, 1971, 1972 and 1973. The results for 1970 and 1971 are from the final Census Reports. Although the results for 1972 are mainly those given in the provisional results for that year improved estimates have been included where possible. The definitions of sales of goods produced etc, of other costs, and of net output differ slightly between 1970-1972 and 1973. The differences are explained in footnotes (b) and (d) and, for net output, below.

#### Definitions

Employment relates to the average number of persons employed during the year.

Gross output measures the total value of production (including work done) by establishments during the year. It is calculated as follows:

Values of sales and work done

Plus/Less: Increase/Decrease in value of stocks of goods on hand for sale

Plus/Less: Increase/Decrease in value of work in progress

= Gross Output

Net output represents the value added to materials by the process of production (including the margin on selling any merchanted or factored goods). It is calculated as follows:

Gross Output

Less: Purchases adjusted for change in value of stocks of fuel and raw materials

Less: Payments for work given out to other establishments

Less: Net amount of any duties, subsidies, allowances and levies payable

= Net Output

NB This is the definition used for 1973 when, except for the mining and quarrying industries, the amounts paid to other organisations for transport were not separately distinguished in the Census. For 1970-1972, data on this item were collected and, with the items shown above, deducted from gross output to arrive at net output. The discontinuity between 1970-1972 and 1973 in the net output series is relatively small for most industries. For the following industries, where the amount paid to other organisations for transport exceeded 3 per cent of gross output, the cost is given for 1971 (1973 for mining and quarrying industries), the latest available figure: 102 (£40m), 103 (£20m), 109 (£4m), 218 (£17m), 271.1 (£15m), 275 (£7m), 278 (£14m), 279.1 (£2m), 395 (with payment for work given out, £8m), 461 (£21m), 463 (£11m), 464 (£24m) and 469.2 (£52m). Details for these and other industries will be found in the reports for 1971 for individual industries (Business Monitor PA series).

#### Year of Return

Firms were asked to make returns for the calendar year 1973 but a return for a business year ending on any date from 6 April 1973 to 5 April 1974 was accepted.

#### Rounding of Figures

Figures in the tables have, where necessary, been rounded to the nearest final digit; there may be an apparent slight discrepancy between the sum of the constituent items and the total shown.
