The Report on the Census of Production for 1958

Part 132. INDEX OF PRODUCTS

This index shows, by reference to the List of Parts at the end, the industry report in which details of the output of a particular commodity are given. The page indicated is that on which appears the figure for total sales of the commodity in 1958 by the larger firms engaged in its production; and also, in a few cases, the estimated figure (based on a sample) for small firms' sales.

The omission of a commodity from the index does not necessarily mean that there was no production in the United Kingdom during 1958, but merely that sales are not separately recorded in the Census reports.

Some items included in the index do not appear separately in the reports, but only as part of a wider group of commodities. Such cases occur where objection was made to the publication of separate figures on account of the disclosure of information relating to individual undertakings.
