Revised travel-to-work areas

Revised travel-to-work areas

Travel-to-work areas are approximations to self-contained labour markets and, as such, form the smallest areas for which unemployment rates are quoted in the *Labour Market Data* section of *Employment Gazette*. This article describes how the travel-to-work areas have been redefined using data on travel patterns obtained from the 1981 Census of Population. Unemployment rates for the new areas are shown in table 2.4 of the *Labour Market Data* section.

In concept, a self-contained labour market area is an area defined so that commuting to and from work all occurs within the boundary of the area. The unemployment rate for such an area—calculated by dividing the number of unemployed who live in the area by the sum of the number of employees who work in the area and the number of unemployed who live there—provides a measure of the mismatch between the supply and demand for labour in the area and can be used to assess the need for additional jobs in the area.

Unemployment rates for areas which are not self-contained in terms of commuting flows are less useful because the relationships between the unemployed and job opportunities in the area is influenced by the situation in adjoining areas. For example, a high rate for an area with substantial out-commuting could primarily reflect the failure of the unemployment rate to take account of many of the jobs available to residents of the area because those jobs are located outside the area; similarly the unemployment rate for an area with a high commuting inflow would be artificially deflated.

Why have travel-to-work areas?

It is sometimes suggested that these problems can be avoided by calculating unemployment rates as the ratio between the unemployed living in an area and the sum of the unemployed and employed living in the area (rather than those working in the area). Even if this could be done—and it should be noted that comprehensive reliable residential employment data for small areas are only available from the decennial Census of Population, effectively ruling out this approach as a routine procedure—such rates, while providing an indicator of social conditions in the area, do not take into account the commuting characteristics of the area. For this reason resident-based rates for an area which is not self-contained, like workplace-based rates for similar areas, need careful interpretation: they do not provide a direct measure of the local mismatch between labour supply and demand and therefore a high rate may not indicate a need for more jobs in a particular area rather than in neighbouring areas.

In practice, it is not possible to divide the country into entirely separate labour market areas such that no-one commutes across the boundaries of those areas—commuting patterns are too diverse. Travel-to-work areas have been developed as approximations to such areas which cover the whole country and are used as the basis for publication of local unemployment rates.

Why revise travel-to-work areas?

Commuting patterns change over time for a variety of reasons including the opening and closing of workplaces, and the development of residential areas of transport facilities. Travel-to-work areas need to be reviewed to reflect

these changes. Up-to-date information on commuting is collected by the Census of Population, the only source of sufficiently consistent and comprehensive data on commuting patterns. An article in the July 1978 issue of *Employment Gazette* described the review based on the 1971 census data. The availability of more up-to-date information from the 1981 census enabled the current review to be undertaken.

Changes in the way in which unemployment and employment data are collected provided a further reason for reviewing the areas. In the past the collection procedures made it impossible to calculate unemployment rates for areas other than Jobcentre areas—or aggregates of those areas. Travel-to-work areas were therefore defined in terms of aggregations of the 900 or so Jobcentre areas. New procedures, and in particular the postcoding of the basic unemployment and employment data, have removed this limitation and it has become possible to define travel-to-work areas using much finer geographic detail than the Jobcentre areas.

In the present review travel-to-work areas in Great Britain have been constituted from the 10,000 or so local authority wards using the ward to ward travel-to-work patterns observed in the 1981 Census of Population.* The new areas in England and Wales are groups of wards as defined in 1981 while those in Scotland are groups of 1984 wards. The travel-to-work areas in Northern Ireland have been defined by the Northern Ireland Department of Economic Development as groups of districts.

Travel-to-work areas generally form the building blocks for defining the regional industrial policy assisted areas, though the travel-to-work area boundaries are not always followed in defining every Assisted Area. The Government is currently engaged in a review of regional industrial policy under which a new Assisted Area map must be defined this autumn. The need to have the new travel-to-work areas defined in time for them to be used in preparing the review Assisted Area map imposed an effective deadline of the end of June for completion of the redefinition of travel-to-work areas.

How have the revised areas been derived?

As explained above, the data used in the review came from the 1981 Census of Population. This provided, for a randomly selected ten per cent of the population, details of both home and workplace address thus describing the commuting patterns of both the residents of each ward and those who worked in each ward.

As a preliminary to their use to derive travel-to-work areas these data were modified to include hypothetical

travel patterns for the unemployed calculated to reflect the commuting patterns of similar people who were in employment. This was done because a relatively high proportion of the unemployed are in socio-economic groups whose employed members typically have relatively short journeys to work and unless this were taken into account the travel-to-work areas would provide a poorer approximation to self-contained local labour markets.

Draft revised travel-to-work areas were then arrived at by applying formulae to the Census of Population data in order to group wards together into areas which were substantially self-contained. The details of the method used to do this are set out in the appendices. The basic criteria used for acceptability as a travel-to-work area were self-containment of 75 per cent (that is the number of people who both live and work in the area should be at least 75 per cent of both the total number of people who work in the area and the total number of workers who live in the area) and a working population, as measured by the Census of Population data described above, of at least 3,500; however, self-containment as low as 70 per cent was accepted for areas with a working population in excess of 20,000. One of the aims of the review was to identify a substantial number of travel-to-work areas. If higher containment ratios had been used there would have been fewer and larger areas, especially in the major urban areas.

When the data had been analysed in this way, draft definitions of travel-to-work areas were circulated to the Scottish and Welsh Offices, the regional offices of the Departments of the Environment and of Trade and Industry, the Manpower Services Commission's Regional Manpower Intelligence Units and, through them, to local authorities. Because of their local knowledge these bodies were invited to comment on the draft areas and, in particular, to pass on information of any recent local development which could have led to changes in travel patterns since the 1981 census (which provides the most recent comprehensive data) was conducted. While the time available for comments was severely limited, because of the need to complete the review in time for the new areas to be used in the redefinition this autumn of the Assisted Areas map, many useful and detailed comments were received and carefully considered in finalising the travel-to-work areas.

The comments received effectively fell into two general categories: information about changes in travel patterns (for example the effect of the opening or closing of a factory), and suggestions for alternative areas which might reflect travel patterns more closely than the draft areas. In the former case the reported changes were considered alongside the census data so as to assess whether the changes were sufficiently large to warrant modification of the boundaries. Where alternative areas were suggested they, and the consequent amendments which were required for nearby areas, were assessed against the criteria used for the review. In a number of cases the areas were revised in the light of the comments received.

At the same time the draft areas were, where necessary, modified to produce contiguous areas. The boundaries of some areas were also slightly modified, where this could be done without affecting the validity of the areas, so as to follow local authority district boundaries more closely.

The new areas are shown in the maps on pages 9/10 and 11 and the detailed definition of the areas—in terms of local authority districts and wards—in appendix 4.

Appendix 1—Derivation of draft travel-to-work areas

The new travel-to-work areas were arrived at separately for England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. The following para-

graphs describe the method* used in England and Wales and then go on to explain the minor ways in which the procedures adopted for Scotland differed from those used for England and Wales, and to describe the methodology employed for Northern Ireland.

The census of population data provided for each ward:

- (i) the number of people who worked in the ward together with the name of the ward in which each of them lived;
- (ii) the number of people in work who lived in the ward together with the name of the ward in which each of them worked; and
- (iii) the number of unemployed who lived in the ward.

The first of these data sets provided for any pair of wards the number of people who travel to work from the first to the second of the pair.

Each of these data items could be classified by socio-economic group (SEG) and it was apparent that the unemployed were relatively concentrated in those SEGs whose employed members typically have relatively short journeys to work. Thus, to ignore the unemployed in arriving at data on travel patterns would have exaggerated the importance of longer journeys. The number of work journeys between wards, derived from the data on the wards in which those in work lived and worked, were therefore adjusted by adding hypothetical travel patterns for the unemployed; these were arrived at by assuming that unemployed residents of a particular ward would have the same travel pattern as employed people of the same SEG living in the same ward.

The algorithm to be applied to these adjusted data on the number of work journeys between wards had to group wards into areas in such a way that most workers living in an area also work in the same area and most people who work in an area also live there. There is no one theoretically correct algorithm for grouping wards in this way and the methods used in the past were inappropriate for the current review because they combined much larger basic building blocks. The algorithm was therefore developed by testing various alternatives and selecting one as the best that could be developed in the time available. In assessing the relative merits of alternative algorithms the factors taken into account included:

- (i) the number of self-contained areas resulting from a given algorithm;
- (ii) the algorithm's ability to subdivide large conglomerate areas;
- (iii) simplicity of operation and of description; and
- (iv) ability to produce contiguous areas.

The algorithm used consisted of five stages. The first stage identified wards which might form part of the core of a travel-to-work area. The second stage combined together those of these wards which had strong commuting links so as to form areas which may be called job foci. In the third stage further wards were grouped round these foci—and some of the foci grouped together—to build up new areas which were at least 50 per cent self-contained; these areas were called proto travel-to-work areas. Next, those wards which had so far remained unattached were added to the proto travel-to-work area with which they had the strongest commuting links. The fifth stage involved splitting the proto travel-to-work area which was furthest from qualifying as a travel-to-work area into its component wards and reallocating each of those wards to the remaining area with which it had the closest commuting links; this stage continued until all remaining areas qualified as travel-to-work areas. These stages are described in more detail below.

The first stage was to identify wards which might form part of the core of a travel-to-work area. Two types of ward were selected at this stage:

- (i) those which because they had many more people working in them than living in them were clearly the destination of a

number of journeys to work; and

- (ii) those which because a high proportion of their residents worked in the ward could, although not necessarily experiencing a substantial amount of in-commuting, form the core of a relatively small but highly self-contained travel-to-work area.

Wards were selected if the number of people working in the ward exceeded the number of workers living there by at least 30 per cent or the number of people both living and working in the ward was at least 55 per cent of the total number of workers living there. About 1,900 wards were identified in England and Wales at this stage, from a total of nearly 9,300.

A number of the wards identified in stage 1 were themselves interrelated and rather than standing in their own right formed parts of a larger core or focus of a travel-to-work area. The second stage therefore grouped together those of the wards identified in the first stage which had significant commuting flows between them. Those of the wards identified in stage 1 which were 50 per cent self-contained (that is the number of people both living and working there was at least half of both the total number of people working there and the total number of workers living there) were accepted as separate job foci.

The others were available for grouping by first considering the ward with the largest net commuting inflow; this ward is referred to below as ward A. Those wards, from among those identified at stage 1, from which at least ten per cent of the resident workers commuted to ward A were regarded as candidates for merger with ward A provided at least one per cent of the workers living in ward A commuted to the candidate ward. Ward A was then merged with the candidate ward with which it had the closest commuting links as measured by the formula described in appendix 2, providing the value given by that formula was at least 0.002. If the resulting combined area was not 50 per cent self-contained, a further ward could be selected, in the same way, to be added to the group. When this procedure was complete, consideration passed to the ward with the next largest net commuting inflow.

A total of about 1,000 groups of wards, including some individual wards, were identified in this way in England and Wales; these areas were termed job foci. The third stage was to begin grouping further wards around these foci. So as to increase the number of separate travel-to-work areas identified on the periphery of the larger areas, the algorithm did not in this single stage create areas which were sufficiently self-contained to qualify as travel-to-work areas but rather developed areas which were moderately self-contained; that is, had self-containment ratios of 50 per cent or more.

This was done by ranking the job foci identified at stage 2 according to the function used to assess an area's viability as a travel-to-work area; this function is described in appendix 3. Those job foci for which the function exceeded 0.625 (a value which corresponds to self-containment of about 50 per cent) were left unchanged by this stage which considered first the focus with the greatest value less than 0.625; this focus is referred to below as area B.

Those wards and job foci (other than those with a value in excess of 0.625) from which at least ten per cent of resident workers commuted to area B were regarded as candidate areas for merger with area B. Area B was then merged with the candidate area with which it had the closest commuting links as measured by the formula described in appendix 2 and this process continued until the resultant area exceeded the threshold value of 0.625 or no further candidate areas could be found. Consideration then passed to the job focus next in the ranking. The areas resulting from this stage may be termed proto travel-to-work areas.

At the end of this third stage there remained some wards which did not form part of a job focus and were not attached to a job focus at stage three. The fourth stage allocated these wards between the proto travel-to-work areas by attaching them to the area with which they had the closest commuting links as measured by the formula described in appendix 2. The wards were considered in descending order of the number of residents in the ward.

At the end of the fourth stage all wards had been grouped into areas but not all of those areas were sufficiently self-contained to qualify as travel-to-work areas. In the fifth stage the area which

was furthest from qualifying as a travel-to-work area—as measured by the function described in appendix 3—was split into its component wards and each of those wards allocated to the remaining area with which it had the closest commuting link. This stage continued until all remaining areas qualified as travel-to-work areas and these areas constituted the draft areas on which comments were invited.

The same procedure was followed in Scotland except that the census data were available for postcode sectors and not for wards. The algorithm therefore produced draft areas for Scotland in terms of groupings of postcode sectors. When the Scottish areas were finalised, in the light of comments received on the draft areas, they were respecified in terms of wards.

A separate review of travel-to-work areas was carried out in Northern Ireland by the Department of Economic Development. As in Great Britain, identification of travel-to-work areas depended basically on the extent to which areas were self-contained in terms of both labour supply and demand. An analysis of journey to work flows, between District Council areas, from the 1981 Northern Ireland Census of Population was carried out using an adaptation of the methodology employed in the original specification of travel-to-work areas in Northern Ireland in 1975. As a result of this exercise the number of areas has been reduced from 13 to 12.

Appendix 2—Formula used to measure the commuting link between two areas

In measuring the strength of the commuting link between two areas a formula was wanted which took account of journeys in both directions—a decision as to whether to attach a ward to a particular area should depend not only on the number of people who commute from the ward to the area concerned but also on the number who commute in the opposite direction.

The formula needs also to take account of the size of the areas concerned—if a choice is being made to attach a ward to one of two areas a simple comparison of the numbers of journeys involved would tend to favour the choice of the larger area. This consideration is particularly important in arriving at an algorithm which produces a substantial number of travel-to-work area without needlessly combining distinct areas. In particular it aids the identification of separate travel-to-work areas in the surrounds of large cities.

In calculating the formula the flow from area A to area B is measured as a proportion of the residents in area A and also as a proportion of the jobs in area B and these two proportions are multiplied together to give a measure of the "importance" of that flow for the areas concerned. The full formula is the sum of the "importances", measured in this way, of the flows in each direction between the two areas. Algebraically the formula is:

$$\frac{F_{a,b}}{R_a} \cdot \frac{F_{a,b}}{W_b} + \frac{F_{b,a}}{R_b} \cdot \frac{F_{b,a}}{W_a}$$

where $F_{a,b}$ is the number of journeys to work from area A to area B; R_a is the number of workers who live in area A; and W_a is the number of people who work in area A.

Appendix 3—The function used to assess an area's viability as a travel-to-work area

In assessing an area's viability as a travel-to-work area a function was required with the following properties:

- (i) An area with self-containment—on both measures—exceeding 75 per cent and at least 3,500 workers living in the area should be accepted.
- (ii) An area with self-containment—on both measures—exceeding 70 per cent and at least 20,000 workers living in the area should be accepted.
- (iii) An area in which fewer than 3,500 workers live should be rejected.
- (iv) An area with self-containment—on either measure—of less than 70 per cent should be rejected.
- (v) For areas where between 3,500 and 20,000 workers live, the

minimum self-containment required—on both measures—for acceptance as a travel-to-work area should progressively decrease from 75 per cent for the smallest areas to 70 per cent for the largest.

The function used was as follows:

$$\min \left\{ \frac{F_{a,a}}{R_a} ; \frac{F_{a,a}}{W_a} ; 0.75 \right\} x$$

$$\min \{ 5.295 R_a ; 18,220 + 0.0885 R_a ; 20,000 \}$$

where $F_{a,a}$ is the number of people who both live and work in the area concerned; R_a is the number of workers who live in the area concerned; and W_a is the number of people who work in the area concerned.

The area is viable as a travel-to-work area if the value of this function exceeds 14,000.

Appendix 4—Definition of revised travel-to-work areas

The revised travel-to-work areas are defined below. For each country in turn, the areas are listed in alphabetical order. Each area is defined by a list of the local authority districts, if any, which fall entirely within the boundaries of the travel-to-work area followed by a list of the remaining wards (grouped according to the districts of which they are a part) in the travel-to-work area. For England and Wales the wards listed are as they were defined in 1981 while for Scotland wards are as defined in 1984.

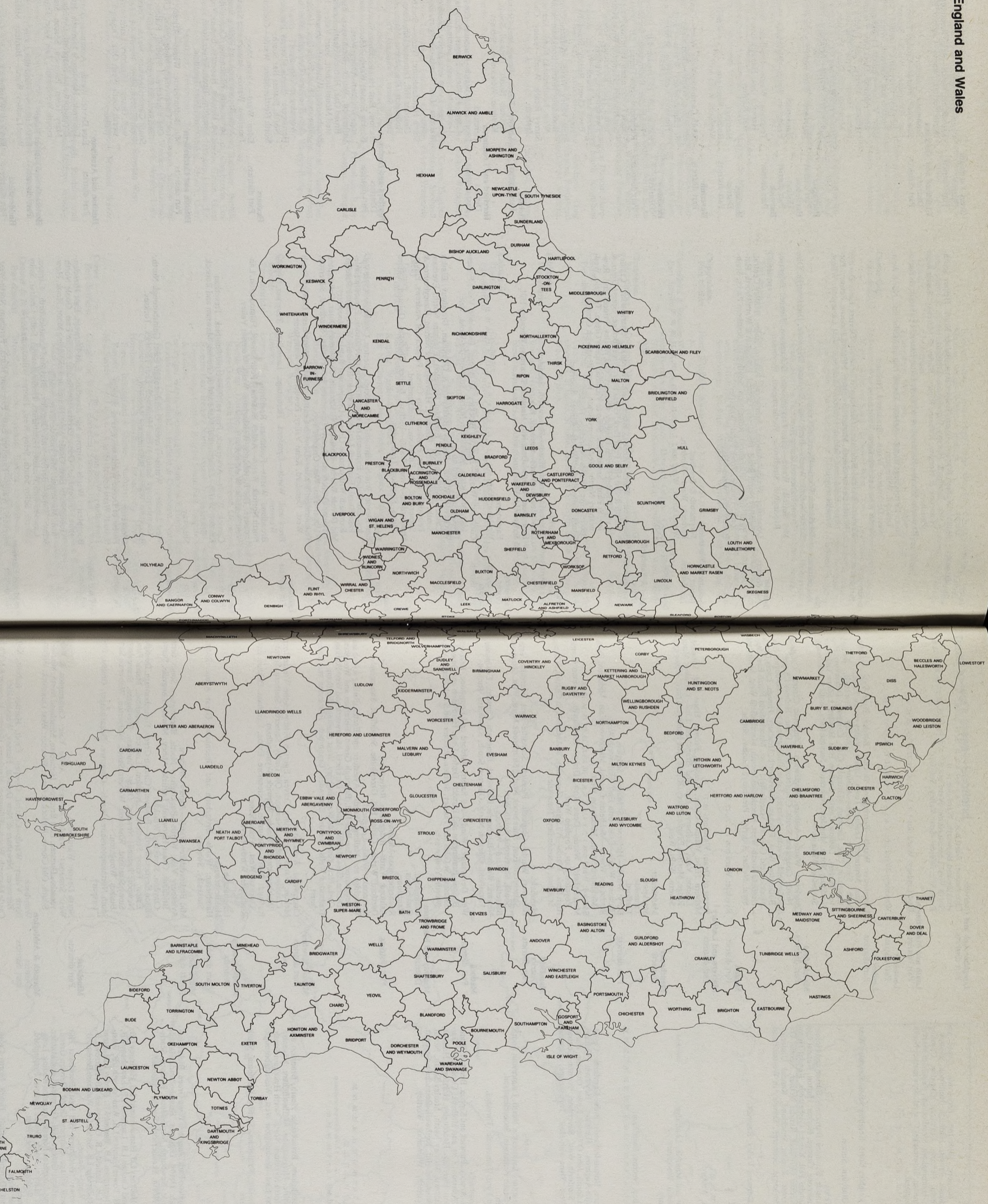
