154 Water supply

This Report on the Water Supply Industry relates to the establishments of public authorities and companies engaged wholly or mainly in purifying and distributing water and supplying hydraulic power. Construction work carried out by employees of water undertakings is included. Private water works maintained by establishments primarily for their own use are excluded.

This industry corresponds to minimum list heading 603 in the Standard Industrial Classification (Revised 1968) which has been used for the first time as a basis of classification in the 1968 census. The definition of this industry however is unchanged from the last detailed Census of Production for 1963 in which it was reported (Part 129).

In most of the tables in this Report the industry has been sub-divided between the public sector 'Public Authorities' and the private sector 'Water Companies'.

METHOD OF CLASSIFICATION

The classification of returns to this industry followed the standard procedure. Classification to the two sub-divisions of the industry shown in Table 4, was, as mentioned above, between the public and private sectors of the industry.

In interpreting the data in the tables it is essential to bear in mind the notes and definitions which appear on pages (i) to (iii).
