BATTERIES AND ACCUMULATORS TRADE

THIS REPORT on the Batteries and Accumulators Trade relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in the manufacture of dry batteries, including radio and flash lamp batteries, and accumulators for all purposes.

This trade corresponds to minimum list heading 75 in the Standard Industrial Classification.

Establishments in this trade in Northern Ireland are excluded in 1948 and included in 1946; no production was recorded there in this trade for 1937 or 1935.
