## DEATHS IN PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS,

1877.

The following pages contain the numbers of deaths registered during 1877 in most of the Public Institutions of England. These figures afford the means of correcting the mortality of districts and sub-districts in which Public Institutions are situated. The list includes Workhouses, Hospitals, Infirmaries, and Public Lunatic Asylums, while Prisons, Almshouses, Schools, Private Lunatic Asylums and Benevolent Asylums, are excluded. The list, as settled, includes 1448 Institutions; of which 721 are Workhouses, Workhouse Infirmaries, or Workhouse Schools; 644 Hospitals or Infirmaries; and 83 Lunatic Asylums. The Lunatic Asylums are mostly County Asylums, but a few private Asylums which receive pauper patients are also included. In these 1448 Institutions 49,332 deaths were registered during the year, or 9·9 per cent. of the total deaths in England and Wales, against 8·8 and 9·1 per cent. in the two preceding years; 32,096 occurred in Workhouses, 12,570 in Hospitals, and 4666 in Lunatic Asylums. Each of these totals exceeded the corresponding number in 1876, and the proportion to total deaths was 6·4 in Workhouses, 2·5 in Hospitals, and 0·9 in Lunatic Asylums.

The principles upon which the Causes of Death are tabled have been explained in previous Annual Reports. It will be sufficient to state now that all diseases are classified in the following and in similar Tables of Causes of Death under 116 heads; some of these heads, however, include groups of diseases which are very distinct from one another, but which either are fatal to only a *few persons*, or are often confounded with other diseases. The rule has been to refer the distinct diseases to analogous heads under which the cases were so numerous, that the additional numbers of diseases really distinct would not materially interfere with the calculated proportions. The Table for England and Wales (pp. 146-155) gives printed in *Italics* the other causes of death bracketed with the heads limited to 116 in the condensed Tables. It will be noticed, for example, that in the class of Local Diseases—such as diseases of the organs of circulation for the sake of brevity designated “Heart Disease,”—in a certain number of instances the precise nature of the malady is given, in other instances all that is recorded is the disease of the organs without any further distinction.
