"People Who Live in Glass Houses----"!
I am much inclined to believe that $M r$ Asquith will be forced out of public life, but I very much doubt if it will be by any action of your's. The beams in your own eyes will interfere I fancy with your chances in that direction.

You denounce the Asquith crowd for the "murdering" of wemen, but what were you doing and what were your crowd doing when the "Minotaur of Modern Babylon ${ }^{\text {s }}$ " memorial was being collected for and going up? What did your crowd, Suffragists included, get to keep shut mouths over that bit of business?

In April pf last year I asked you to interest your self in the Bread Question which the "Daily Mail" that "Champion exploiter of Men and things" -I/did not go behing its back to call it-
 main facts the "D .Mail" was going upon had been filched from papers of my own which had been prepared for Mr Joseph Gels, and in reply to absurdities in the "Englishman". To my request I received a reply that you were quite unable to take up any fresh question!!!

Was that reply dictated by the interest you had in Mr Joseph Gels, whom doubtless you were not ill informed had been showhimself to me as being of the order of the cad, and had made use of matter supplied to him by myself to oblige his friends at my expense ?

Have you any idea how many wemen and children you have assisted to murder by your action towards me, dictated by your own selfinterest? They are not to be counted by one's or two's but by thousands and the day is near at hand when the public shall have an opportunity of seeing you and your friends, James Meir Hardie included, in a broader light than they have yet had an opportunity of seeing your. in.

I fear me much that with the Asquith crowd there will be an exodus from public life that will not add to your comfort or that of your friends Fell, Hardie \& Co., and those of No 4, 5 \& 6 Clements Inn. I send a copy of this to Mr Asquith.
