

Roundtable on Yemeni Dialogue and Civic Engagement

Working with the Conflict Analysis and Research Centre, ORG's Strategic Peacebuilding Programme organised a successful roundtable at the University of Kent on 01 December 2017. Entitled Yemen: Devising a sustainable process for dialogue and civic engagement, it was attended by some 40 people and brought together Yemeni and international practitioners and academics with British policy-makers from the Department for International Development (DFID), Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) and Stabilisation Unit.

The roundtable provided a space for specialists on Yemen and in peacebuilding to cross fertilise and have a practical interactive discussion around what can be done to improve the peace process through civic engagement.
