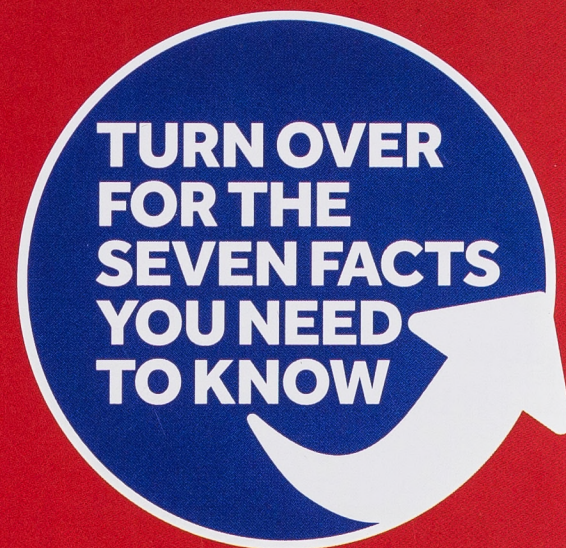

THE SEVEN FACTS YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE THE EU REFERENDUM



1 Over 3 million UK jobs are linked to our trade with the EU: one in every ten jobs in this country *(Source: HM Treasury).*



MORE JOBS

2 Being in the EU means more growth in the UK. Overall, if we left the EU, UK households would be worse off by £4,300 a year *(Source: HM Treasury).*



LOWER PRICES

3 Competition across the EU means lower prices in UK shops – saving British households £350 a year *(Source: London School of Economics Centre for Economic Performance).*

4 Leaving the EU would hit the UK economy, and mean government spending cuts of £36 billion – meaning less money for the NHS *(Source: HM Treasury).*

5 UK businesses can trade in a home market of 500 million consumers in the EU without tariffs or barriers – 44% of our exports go to the EU *(Source: Office of National Statistics).*

6 The UK gets £66 million of investment every day from EU countries *(Source: Office of National Statistics).* That's more than we pay to be a member of the EU.

7 More than 200,000 British businesses trade with the EU, helping them create jobs here in the UK *(Source: HMRC).*
