Conservatives for Britain's Parliamentary supporters have been working to help secure a fair referendum and build a mainstream, credible 'leave' campaign. Our key achievements to date include:

Helping to deliver a fair referendum, by:

- Successfully re-introducing purdah rules into the EU Referendum Act for the final 28 days of the campaign, making sure that Government resources cannot be deployed to the benefit of either side
- Working to change the referendum question, so that both the 'remain' and 'leave' options are on the ballot paper
- Keeping the Conservative Party neutral, meaning that Party resources cannot be deployed on behalf of either side
