Unfair Immigration



The open-door immigration system of the European Union means anyone from the European Union can come to work here, while skilled workers from other countries are blocked. If we left the EU we could have a "points-based" system like Australia that ensures that Britain gets the incoming workers it needs, no more and no less.

Fall in wages

Since 2010 wages have fallen behind inflation by a massive 8.6%, meaning a real terms cut in wages. The drop has been driven by new immigration from the European Union with 510,000 new National Insurance registrations in 2014, on top of 617,000 in 2013 and more in previous years. This has hit the lower paid worst as they spend a higher proportion of their wages on essentials and have fewer savings.



Restore British Control



Once we vote to leave the European Union, the British Parliament will regain democratic control over immigration and other matters. Immigration has helped Britain in the past - immigrants have included the composer Handel, poet T.S. Eliot and the founders of Marks & Spencer - but we need a carefully controlled policy, not the open doors policy forced on us by the European Union.


Impact on lower earners



Over an 8 year period immigration held back wages for the lowest paid workers. The impact on the 10% lowest paid workers was three times that on the 10% top paid.

Rise in foreign born employment

The rise in foreign-born employment in the UK has been nearly six times that for UK-born workers. The trend continues. In 2014 EU migrants found 3 jobs in the UK for every job that went to a UK citizen. Again, low-skilled workers are hardest hit.
