# Housing Return for England and Wales as at 30th September, 1946

This return is the ninth of a series of monthly progress statements on housing in England and Wales. The figures in the present return show the position up to 30th September, 1946, and relate from 1st April, 1945. The return includes an Appendix A giving general tables relating to England and Wales as a whole and to various subdivisions by types of authority and by geographical distribution.

The \*first issue included general explanatory notes which have not been repeated n this return.

A detailed statement for each of the 1,469 housing authorities will shortly be published as a separate document (Appendix B).

Besides the total provision of additional accommodation as set out above, 644,000 dwellings which were damaged during the war but not so severely as to be unfit for occupation were repaired during the eighteen months ending 30th September, 1946.

#### PERMANENT NON-TRADITIONAL HOUSES

With the object of accelerating the rate at which houses can be erected a number of methods of house construction have been evolved which, for ease of reference, are known as "non-traditional". Included in this category are types that have been referred to as "permanent prefabricated". In Appendix A, Table II, a list of the main types is given together with details regarding the numbers of each type for which tenders have been approved and the numbers completed. Information regarding the development of sites and the preparation of housing schemes for non-traditional houses is included in the figures shown in Appendix A, Tables I, 2, 8 and 9.

#### REBUILDING OF WAR DESTROYED HOUSES

The rebuilding of war destroyed houses by private builders to private contract can be undertaken only under licence. Rebuilding by local authorities can be begun with the approval of the Ministry of Health and War Damage Commission. The figures for September take into account information regarding houses approved and on licences issued and houses completed in earlier months which was not previously available. Information in respect of some Local Authorities is still incomplete and the figures quoted are subject to adjustment. #### USE OF EXISTING PREMISES

Apart from new building additional accommodation for family units has also been provided by Local Authorities and by private builders under licence by the repair or adaptation of existing premises.

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Information in regard to such provision made by Local Authorities has been published in earlier housing returns. Corresponding information relating to the provision made by private builders under licence was available for the first time in April, 1946. The data available may be summarised as follows:—

Revised information in respect of the period prior to July, 1946, has been received from Local Authorities, and consequent adjustments have been made to figures previously quoted. It is anticipated that further revision will be necessary in respect of figures for the repair of unoccupied war damaged dwellings. The existing figures should therefore be regarded as provisional.

OTHER HOUSING ACCOMMODATION

A total of 29,240 flats and houses of less than 12 rooms was released from occupation by the Services and Government Departments over the period 1st May, 1945, to 31st August, 1946. Some of the dwellings on release were taken over by the Local Authorities.

The total number of requisitioned dwellings held by the Local Authorities for residential purposes was 91,673 at the end of September; of these 57,782

were situated in the London region.

Of the total of 91,673 requisitioned dwellings held by the Local Authorities, 69,275 were held at 31st March, 1945. From that date to 31st August, 1946, there was a net increase in unoccupied houses requisitioned by Local Authorities for residential purposes of 21,811 and a further 643 were requisitioned in September, making a net increase of 22,454 houses in the 18 months to 30th September, 1946.

PROGRESS OF INDIVIDUAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES

Of the total of 1,469 Authorities there were at the 30th September, 1946, 26 Authorities, excluding L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs, who had as yet no sites of which possession had been obtained. Of these Authorities 14 were urban areas (mainly small urban districts) and 11 rural districts; the population in these areas represents 0·4 per cent. of the total population of England and Wales. There were 27 Authorities, excluding L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs, who had not obtained authority to go to tender on a specific scheme. The population in the area of these Authorities represents 0·8 per cent. of the total population of England and Wales.

HOUSING LABOUR FORCE

The total number of operatives aged 16 and over, excluding prisoners of war, employed on the construction or repair of housing in England and Wales,

whether on work for local authorities or on private contracts under licence, grew from 320,400 in July, 1945 to 549,500 at 27th September, 1946. At 30th August, 1946, the number so employed was 540,000. Within the total housing labour force, the number employed on war damage repairs decreased from 147,000 at 30th August, to 146,000 at 27th September, while the number employed on the construction of permanent houses grew from 140,700 to 150,600.

#### APPENDIX A-NOTES

The material contained in this return is derived from a census of the housing position at 31st December, 1945, and the reports of subsequent progress completed by the Local Authorities. At the 17th October, 1946, reports of progress had not been received from 1 Authority for the months April–September, from 2 authorities for the months June–September, from 3 Authorities for the months August and September and from 15 Authorities for the month of September. Reports of progress in September were due to be received by the 5th October, 1946. Reports received after 17th October arrived too late to be included in the figures shown in this report relating to progress in September. By 17th October, 1946, 1,448 reports had been received.

Classification of Urban and Rural Authorities

The classification of Urban Authorities other than the L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs into Large Towns and Cities, Medium Towns and Cities and Small Towns has been made in terms of population. The classification has been made as follows based on the estimated population at mid-1939 as returned by the Registrar General.

Large Towns and Cities ... ... over 75,000

Medium Towns and Cities ... over 25,000 and up to 75,000

Small Towns ... 25,000 and under

The Rural Authorities comprise all Rural District Councils.

Certain changes in the composition of the Northern, North Midlands and North Western Regions were made as from 1st April, 1946. As from the same date the "North Eastern Region" is to be known as "East and West Ridings". The Description and composition of the Regions are now as follows—

Table 8 shows the numbers of sites at different stages from the initial stage of selection to the stage when the site is available for construction.

Between the selection of the site and the completion of houses ready for occupation there is a long chain of events equivalent to the "pipeline" of materials and components of mass production in the engineering industry.

In general the use of the site for housing requires consideration from the point of view of regional and town planning, local transport facilities and so on. Sites have then to be acquired, a layout agreed, and roads, sewers and other services provided generally in advance of beginning the actual erection of houses. The actual construction of the houses themselves is the final process in the chain of production, which also, of course, comprises the fabrication of building materials and components ready for use.

During the early stages of expanding the volume of house building, the number of house sites under development and the number of houses under construction and so on will continue to rise in advance of a corresponding increase in the number of houses completed. As the production of houses by Local Authorities evolves into a smooth and continuous cycle of operations, the number of houses or house sites at the various stages in the chain of production will tend to be roughly equal.

Table 9 shows the number of houses at different stages towards completion beginning with the preparation of house plans.

Many of the initial stages in the erection of houses such as the preparation of house plans, bills of quantities and the chain of events leading to the acceptance of a tender are, in many cases, undertaken concurrently with the work of developing the corresponding sites.







### NOTES

1. An alphabetical index of Regions and Counties is shown on page 78.

2. The data shown in this Appendix has been based on Appendix B to the Housing Return for England and Wales for the 31st January, 1946, and includes additions and alterations notified in monthly Progress Reports up to and including September 1946, received from Local Authorities. In cases where entries in the Progress Reports were incomplete or inconsistent the information contained in this Appendix has been compiled in the light of evidence contained in the Census Return and in the Progress Reports as a whole. The tabular statement shows the position as at the 30th September. In certain instances Progress Reports have not been received in time for inclusion. Those local authorities in respect of whom Progress Reports for July, August and September, 1946, have not been received are marked with \*, † and § respectively. The data in respect of permanent housing shown for such authorities relates to the position as at the 30th June, 31st July, and 31st August 1946, respectively.

3. In certain cases temporary houses have been handed over to Local Authorities for occupation before all internal fitments have been installed. Where this has been done the number of temporary houses shown as completed (Column (13)) has been marked ø and the name of the Local Authority and the number of houses included in the figure shown in Column 13 which are not complete with all fitments is stated at the foot of the page.

4. Rebuilding of war destroyed houses. The data shown in Columns (6), (7) (17) and (18) has been revised in accordance with information received from local authorities in addition to that contained in Progress Reports, and from information received from the War Damage Commission. Certain information is still awaited in respect of some authorities. In such cases adjustments will be made in later Returns.

5. The term "under construction" in Columns (4), (6), (15) and (17), means that the contractor has actually begun work on the construction of the dwellings. In some instances work has begun on all dwellings in a particular contract; in a few cases it would appear that all the dwellings in a particular scheme have been shown as "under construction" on the Progress Report although work has not necessarily started on all of them.

6. In certain instances the Ministry of Works are undertaking the erection of groups of experimental permanent non-traditional houses on sites provided by housing authorities. These houses have been included in the data shown for the authorities concerned.

7. The number of temporary houses allocated to housing authorities is under constant review. Where the allocation is less than the number of sites available subsequent allocations may be made.

8. Where Tenders (or Estimates in the case of Direct Labour) for site development (Roads and Sewers) have been approved by the Ministry of Health but where work on the site has not yet begun, the sites have not been shown as under development (Column (2)).

9. In the few instances where sites developed before the war by private enterprise are being taken over by the local authority but possession has not yet been obtained, the relevant figures have been entered in Column (2).

10. Permanent Houses. The figures in all columns except Columns (4) and (5) are not included in any other column. "Houses under construction" (Column (4)) and "Houses completed" (Column (5)) are included in "Houses on Tenders Approved" quoted in Column (3).

11. It should be noted that the greater part of the housing provision for the County of London is made by the London County Council. It is not, therefore, possible to relate the data shown in this Appendix for each Metropolitan Borough to the housing needs of the population of the Borough.

The bulk of the preliminary work in connection with the provision of permanent houses made by certain housing associations in the County of London area is undertaken by the Metropolitan Boroughs. The information is included in Columns (14), (15) and (16).

Certain data on temporary houses in respect of the London County Council and the Metropolitan Boroughs have been consolidated.

12. The total number of dwellings on licences issued (Column 14) includes licences issued both in regard to new dwellings and to the rebuilding of war destroyed dwellings. An analysis of the respective numbers falling into these two categories is shown in Tables 4a, 4b and 5a of Appendix A to the Housing Return.

The total number of licences shown in Column 14 also takes into account information received from local authorities in respect of any licences that may have lapsed. The data received in respect of licences may not in all cases be complete and may, therefore, be subject to correction.

13. The numbers of houses on licences issued, under construction and completed by Housing Associations is included in Columns (14), (15) and (16).
