Housing Return for England and Wales as at 31st March, 1948

This return is the twenty-seventh of a series of monthly progress statements on housing in England and Wales. The figures in the present return show the position up to 31st March, 1948, and relate from 1st April, 1945. The return includes an Appendix A giving general tables relating to England and Wales as a whole and to various subdivisions by types of authority and by geographical distribution.

A detailed statement for each of the 1,470 housing authorities will shortly be published as a separate document (Appendix B).

PERMANENT NON-TRADITIONAL HOUSES— LOCAL AUTHORITIES (except Permanent Aluminium Houses)

With the object of accelerating the rate at which houses can be erected a number of methods of house construction have been evolved which, for ease of reference, are known as "non-traditional". In Appendix A, Table 11, a list of the main types is given together with details regarding the numbers of each type for which tenders have been approved and the numbers completed. Information regarding the development of sites and the preparation of housing schemes for non-traditional houses is included in the figures shown in Appendix A, Tables 1, 2, 8 and 9, and is shown in detail in Table 2b.

REBUILDING OF WAR DESTROYED HOUSES

Rebuilding by Local Authorities can be begun with the approval of the Ministry of Health and War Damage Commission. USE OF EXISTING PREMISES

Apart from new building additional accommodation for family units has also been provided by Local Authorities and by private builders under licence by the repair or adaptation of existing premises.

Information relating to accommodation provided by private builders under licence became available for the first time in April, 1946. That in respect of the repair of unoccupied war damaged dwellings may be incomplete for a few Local Authorities and the figures quoted are subject to adjustment. OTHER HOUSING ACCOMMODATION

A total of 31,582 flats and houses of less than 12 rooms was released from occupation by the Services and Government Departments over the period 1st May, 1945, to 29th February, 1948. Some of the dwellings on release were taken over by the Local Authorities.

The total number of requisitioned dwellings held by the Local Authorities for residential purposes was 96,969 at the end of March; of these 61,247 were situated in the London region.

Of the total of 96,969 requisitioned dwellings held by the Local Authorities, 69,275 were held at 31st March, 1945. From that date to 29th February, 1948, there was a net increase in unoccupied houses requisitioned by Local Authorities for residential purposes of 27,750 and 56 were released in March, 1948, making a net increase of 27,694 houses in the 36 months to 31st March, 1948.

SERVICE CAMPS—TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION

In addition to accommodation referred to above, there were at 31st March, 1948, 19,239 families occupying accommodation in 1,350 camps redundant to the needs of the Services or Government Departments, which had been offered to local Authorities for housing purposes and were considered suitable for those purposes. In the main these camps had been taken over by Local Authorities as part of their pool of housing accommodation or were being managed by them on behalf of the Ministry of Health.

Those family units of accommodation included in the number quoted above that are shown in the Summary on page 4, are at least up to the standard of the temporary accommodation already included in the Summary.

Accommodation for a further 957 families was occupied in 120 camps which are still required for Government purposes, or are unsuitable for housing, or are still subject to decision as to their future use.

Accommodation in camps remaining under the control of Service Departments has been provided for 225 families of men still serving in the Forces.

HOUSES LET TO COAL MINERS AND AGRICULTURAL WORKERS

PROGRESS OF INDIVIDUAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES

Of the total of 1,470 Authorities there were at the 31st March, 1948, 9 Authorities, excluding L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs, who had as yet no sites of which possession had been obtained. Of these Authorities 6 were urban areas (mainly small urban districts) and 3 rural districts; the population in these areas represents 0.074 per cent. of the total population of England and Wales. There were 8 Authorities, excluding L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs, who had not obtained authority to go to tender on a specific scheme. The population in the area of these Authorities represents 0.065 per cent. of the total population of England and Wales.

HOUSING LABOUR FORCE

Returns of the number of operatives aged 16 and over employed on the construction of new houses are now based on a new system of collecting the data recently instituted by the Ministry of Works. The estimate of 228,800 so employed in England and Wales at the end of March may still be incomplete and, therefore, subject to adjustment. It should be noted that this estimate relates to operatives engaged both on the construction of permanent houses and on the preparation of housing sites. The number employed on war damage repairs decreased from 85,200 at the end of February, 1948, to 84,200 at the end of March.

BUILDING MATERIALS AND COMPONENTS

Details of production of the more important building materials and components are included in Appendix A. The information relates to Great Britain as a whole; separate details in respect of England and Wales are not available. It should be noted that the production of the items listed is utilised not only for the construction of and installation in new dwellings but also for repairs and replacements and building work other than house building.

In general the production in any given month is not known until towards the end of the following month. It is not therefore always possible for the complete data relating to the month under review to be available in time for inclusion in the Return.

APPENDIX A—NOTES

The material contained in this Return is derived from a census of the housing position at 31st December, 1945, and the reports of subsequent progress completed by the Local Authorities. Certain information is obtained from Government Departments. Where this is the case the items concerned have been annotated. At the 14th April, 1948, reports of progress had not been received from 3 Authorities for the months of February and March and from 47 Authorities for the month of March. Reports of progress in March were due to be received by the 5th April, 1948. Reports received after 14th April arrived too late to be included in the figures shown in this report relating to progress in February. By 14th April, 1948, 1,420 reports had been received.

Classification of Urban and Rural Authorities

The classification of Urban Authorities other than the L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs into Large Towns and Cities, Medium Towns and Cities and Small Towns has been made in terms of population. The classification has been made as follows based on the estimated population at mid-1939 as returned by the Registrar General.

Regions

Certain changes in the composition of the Northern, North Midlands and North Western Regions were made as from 1st April, 1946. As from that date the "North Eastern Region" became known as "East and West Ridings Region". The Description and composition of the Regions are now as follows—

<i>Northern</i>	Cumberland, Durham, Northumberland, Westmorland and the North Riding of Yorkshire.
<i>East and West Ridings</i>	The East and West Ridings of Yorkshire.
<i>North Midlands</i>	Derbyshire (except the High Peak District), Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Northamptonshire (including the Soke of Peterborough), Nottinghamshire and Rutland.
<i>Eastern</i>	Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire (including the Isle of Ely), Essex, Hertfordshire, Huntingdonshire, Norfolk and Suffolk, except such parts of Essex and Hertfordshire as are within the London Region.

<i>London</i>	London (Administrative County), Middlesex and parts of Kent, Essex, Hertfordshire and Surrey.
<i>Southern</i>	Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Dorset, Hampshire (including the Isle of Wight) and Oxfordshire.
<i>South Western</i>	Cornwall, Devon, Gloucestershire, Somerset and Wiltshire and Isles of Scilly.
<i>Wales</i>	The whole of Wales and Monmouthshire.
<i>Midlands</i>	Herefordshire, Shropshire, Staffordshire, Warwickshire and Worcestershire.
<i>North Western</i>	Cheshire, Lancashire and the High Peak District of Derbyshire.

Table 8 shows the numbers of sites at different stages from the initial stage of selection to the stage when the site is available for construction.

Between the selection of the site and the completion of houses ready for occupation there is a long chain of events equivalent to the "pipeline" of materials and components of mass production in the engineering industry.

In general the use of the site for housing requires consideration from the point of view of regional and town planning, local transport facilities and so on. Sites have then to be acquired, a layout agreed, and roads, sewers and other services provided generally in advance of beginning the actual erection of houses. The actual construction of the houses themselves is the final process in the chain of production, which also, of course, comprises the fabrication of building materials and components ready for use.

Table 9 shows the number of houses at different stages towards completion beginning with the preparation of house plans.

Many of the initial stages in the erection of houses such as the preparation of house plans, bills of quantities and the chain of events leading to the acceptance of a tender are, in many cases, undertaken concurrently with the work of developing the corresponding sites.

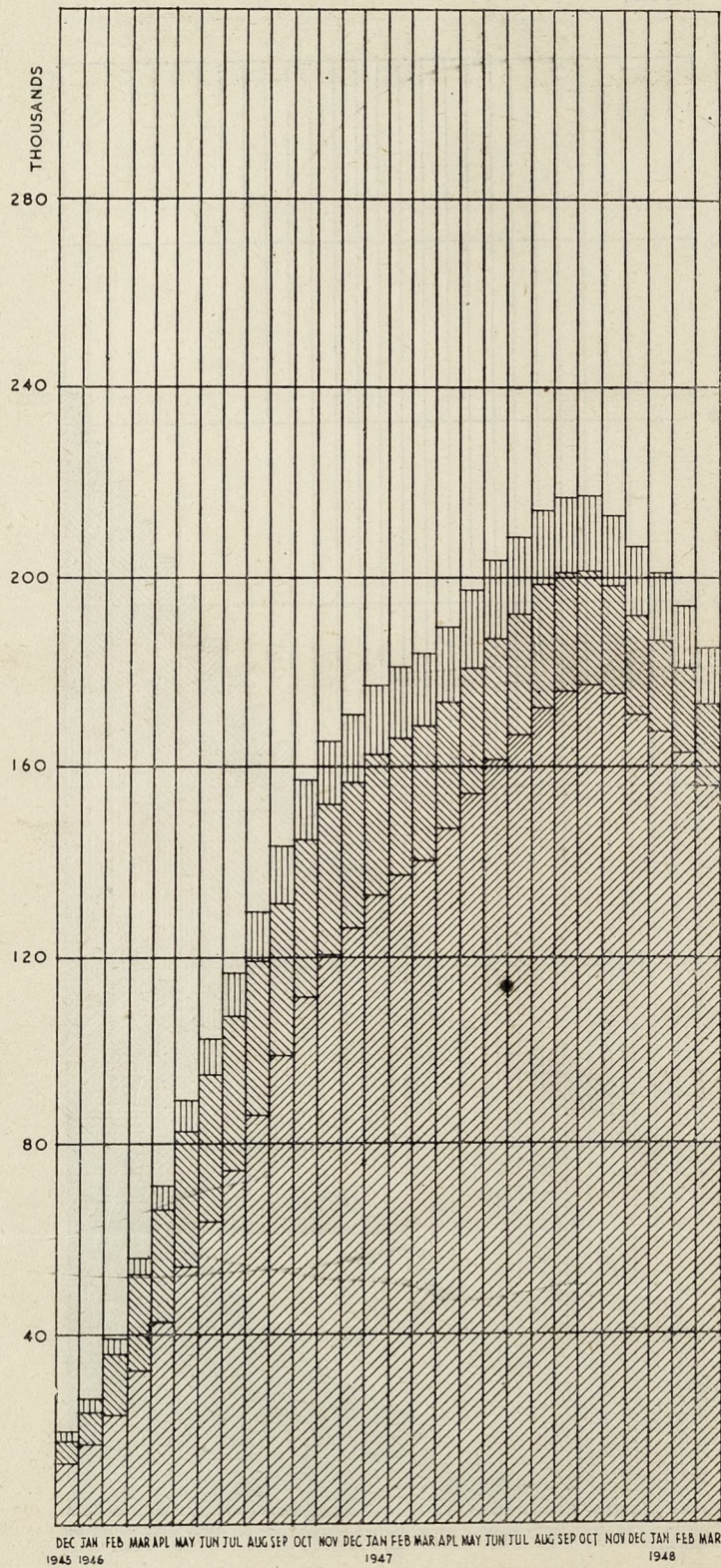
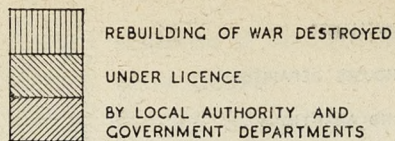
PERMANENT HOUSES

1. An alphabetical index of Regions and Counties is shown on page 78.
2. The data shown in this Appendix has been based on Appendix B to the Housing Return for England and Wales for the 31st January, 1946, and includes additions and alterations notified in monthly Progress Reports up to and including March, 1948, received from Local Authorities. In cases where entries in the Progress Reports were incomplete or inconsistent the information contained in this Appendix has been compiled in the light of evidence contained in the Census Return and in the Progress Reports as a whole. The tabular statement shows the position as at the 31st March, 1948. In certain instances Progress Reports have not been received in time for inclusion. Those local authorities in respect of whom Progress Reports for February and March, 1948, have not been received are marked with * and † respectively. The data in respect of permanent housing shown for such authorities relates to the position as at the 31st January, 1948 and 29th February, 1948, respectively.
3. The term "under construction" in Columns (4), (7), (9), (16) and (18), means that the contractor has actually begun work on the construction of the dwellings. In some instances work has begun on all dwellings in a particular contract; in a few cases it would appear that all the dwellings in a particular scheme have been shown as "under construction" on the Progress Report although work has not necessarily started on all of them.
4. In certain instances the Ministry of Works are undertaking the erection of groups of experimental permanent non-traditional houses on sites provided by housing authorities. These houses have been included in the data shown for the authorities concerned.
5. Where Tenders (or Estimates in the case of Direct Labour) for site development (Roads and Sewers) have been approved by the Ministry of Health but where work on the site has not begun, the sites have not been shown as under development (Col (2)).
6. In the few instances where sites developed before the war by private enterprise are being taken over by the local authority but possession has not yet been obtained, the relevant figures have been entered in Column (2).
7. Permanent Houses. Permanent Aluminium houses are shown separately from other types in Columns (6), (7) and (8). "Houses under construction" (Columns (4) and (7)) and "Houses completed" (Columns (5) and (8)) are included on "Houses in tenders approved" (Columns (3) and (6)) otherwise, figures in each column are not included in any other column.
8. It should be noted that the greater part of the housing provision for the County of London is made by the London County Council. It is not, therefore, possible to relate the data shown in this Appendix for each Metropolitan Borough to the housing needs of the population of the Borough.
The bulk of the preliminary work in connection with the provision of permanent houses made by certain housing associations in the County of London area is undertaken by the Metropolitan Boroughs. The information is included in Columns (3), (4) and (5).
Certain data on temporary houses in respect of the London County Council and the Metropolitan Boroughs have been consolidated.
9. The erection of some temporary houses has been completed but their connection to electric and other services has not been effected. Where this is the case the number of temporary houses shown as completed (Column (14)) has been marked ‡ and the name of the Local Authority and the number of houses completed but not ready for occupation are stated at the foot of the page. Such houses are not included in the number shown as completed in Column (14).
10. The total number of dwellings on licences issued (Column (15)) includes licences issued both in regard to new dwellings and to the rebuilding of war destroyed dwellings. An analysis of the respective numbers falling into these two categories is shown in Tables 4a and 5a of Appendix A to the Housing Return.
The total number of licences shown in Column (15) also takes into account information received from local authorities in respect of any licences that may have lapsed. The data received in respect of licences may not in all cases be complete and may, therefore, be subject to correction.
11. The numbers of houses on licences issued or approved under Section 94 of the Housing Act, 1936 (as amended by Section 8 of the Housing (Financial Provisions) Act, 1938), under construction and completed by Housing Associations are included in Columns (3), (4) and (5) respectively. In Returns prior to that for 31st July, 1947, this information was included in Columns (14), (15) and (16). The numbers of such houses included in Columns (3), (4) and (5) are shown at the foot of each page for each Local Authority concerned.
12. Temporary Houses. In returns up to that for 31st October, 1947, the numbers of temporary houses allocated to Local Authorities have been shown in Column (10). Since all houses allocated are now "under construction" or "completed" this column has been omitted.
13. Houses being built for agricultural workers under Housing (Financial Provisions) Act, 1938, Section 3, in Returns up to and including January, 1948, were shown as being built by Housing Authorities (Columns (3), (4) and (5)). They are now shown as being built under licence since the houses are built by private builders for owner occupation or for letting by owner and not for letting by Housing Authorities.
