When Mrs. Kuntz came this
morning, I opened it, as I could
make out the post mark.
I have not read it. I see from
a newspaper cutting that Mr.
Kuntz is dead, and there is
a leaf poem which I will send
you as soon as I can. I will not write
Mrs. Kuntz myself until I
have had the information through
you. It seems he died some time
ago, but we never heard of it.
Mrs. Cannon came in last night
and I asked him about the
ward. He will be very glad to
see it, and have the rent and
expenses according. I feel sure
you will do right to come to the
house for two or three years or
longer if you like. I will tell you
as soon as I know when we
shall have to move.
