SWIMMING COMPETITIONS. Local baths can be hired. Prizes given and entrance money taken.

DINNER to meet speaker of the Union or other celebrity.

CAFÉ CHANTANT. Members of the Actresses League might be kind enough to assist local talent.

GARDEN PARTIES with out-door theatricals.

FRIDGE and WHIST DRIVES. Prizes to be given, each player to pay one shilling or half a crown table money.

competitions advertised in local paper for best Suffrage poster, essay or poem. The latter might be on any subject. Prizes to be given, entrance money to be profit.

MARKET STALL. These have proved a great attraction when worked with literature. The idea might be developed for selling anything made by suffragists, sweets, fancy articles, books, millinery, blouses, on the lines of a bazaar.

Ladies who are skilled dress-makers, gardeners or milliners might take engagements.

We hope to have the design of the Bugle Girl of the Procession poster reduced to suit collecting cards, programmes, At Home cards. Further suggestions in connection with above will be sent if desired.
