UNION OF JEWISH WOMEN.

REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDING 30th NOVEMBER, 1928.

The Committee of the Union of Jewish Women present their Report for 1928, and are happy to state that whilst former activities have been well maintained there have been new developments of value alike to the Community and to the individuals more closely affected. Noteworthy is the consolidation of the scheme inaugurated in 1927 for the establishment of flatlets to accommodate ladies of limited means, and the impetus given by the Union for the re-establishment of the Bethnal Green Jewish Girls' Club.

Whilst undertaking certain specialised work, the true function of the Union of Jewish Women is, however, an ethical movement to link together women of one faith, whose interests may be widely apart in their ordinary walk of life, but to whom the ideals of Judaism make a strong appeal for unity in their efforts for culture and for social welfare, more especially in respect to improved conditions for women and children.

With each closing year's review we place on record the names of friends and colleagues who have passed from our midst. In this sad list for 1928 are Mrs. Salis Simon of Manchester, one of the Union's original members and to the last an active worker for her people, and Frau Henrietta May of Berlin, chairman of the Jüdischer Frauenbund and our valued Correspondent.

Miss Hannah Karminski has consented to act as Correspondent for Berlin in the future.

Committee There have been two resignations from the Executive Body during the year:—that of Mrs. Charles Waley Cohen, by reason of her frequent absence from London, and that of Miss Iris Castello, on account of pressure of other work. For their help and co-operation during past years the Committee offer thanks. Mrs. Charles Waley Cohen has given most valuable help

as Hon. Secretary of the Overseas Students' Hospitality Committee.

Lady (Herbert) Samuel has joined the Executive Committee and is very warmly welcomed.

Meetings *The Annual General Meeting* was held at 35, Porchester Terrace, by kind permission of Sir Herbert and Lady Samuel, on February 20th. Mr. Ernest Lesser addressed the Meeting on "The Religious Training of the Adolescent" and there was an animated discussion opened by the Rev. Walter Levin and Miss Doris Herz. *Two Council Meetings* were subsequently held. On the 19th of March at the Office of the Union, reports were given on the Union of Jewish Women's Homes Association, Ltd., and the steps taken in regard to the organisation of the Bethnal Green Jewish Girls' Club. At a Meeting held on May 17th, at her house, Lady Spielman introduced the subject of "Groups for the Study of Jewish Subjects," which was received with great interest, and the First Study Circle has been started by Mrs. Laurie Rosenfeld and Mrs. de Pinna Weil.

Social Gathering A Garden Party for Workers and Friends of the Union was kindly given by Mrs. Hillier Holt at "The Poplars," Avenue Road, on June 28th, and was greatly appreciated. In this connection the Committee desire to draw the attention of their members to opportunities for giving pleasure to students and to workers whose lives are somewhat monotonous, by an occasional gift of Concert or Theatre tickets. If sent to the office they can always be placed where they will bring welcome recreation and a few hours' happiness.

Office. The Secretary, Miss Gilbey, resigned early in the year and the opportunity was taken to reorganise the Office in order to secure an ultimate reduction in expenditure. Miss Eileen Van Noorden, who had given efficient help in the Office for over eight years, first as clerk and later as Assistant Secretary, was appointed Secretary, with a junior assistant, and the new arrangements are proving satisfactory. Miss M. Simmons gave valuable assistance during the period when the change was first made and before the clerk was engaged and has later acted as one of the Union's most helpful volunteers.

Volunteers Miss Ruth Barnett, the Treasurer of the Necessitous Ladies' Fund, Miss Esther Nassauer, who comes to the Office unfailingly two mornings a week, Miss Ena Kahn, Miss Ray Rosenfeld, and Miss Julie Woolf, have given valuable voluntary service, and have helped during periods of special pressure of work in the office.

Employment As an employment agency the Union can render certain services, but in many cases applicants have already exhausted every avenue of enquiry, and year by year also it is increasingly difficult to place the woman with inadequate training or experience. For well-qualified Secretaries, Matrons and Nurses, there are always opportunities, and the Committee are grateful for information regarding vacancies and suitable candidates. A new problem has presented itself lately, that of well-educated French, German, Swiss, or Dutch girls seeking *au pair* posts, unable to maintain themselves otherwise and desirous of improving their knowledge of English and of social conditions here. This problem is almost insoluble.

Scholarship Mrs. Hoster, with a generosity which is as fully appreciated by the Committee as by the successful candidate, has again given a scholarship at her Secretarial College to a nominee of the Union, and has accepted another candidate for training next year.

Votes for Women Seatholders in the Synagogue for which the Union has been agitating for years has not been actively pursued during the past year, as this matter is in the hands of an independent Committee, but the question is not being lost sight of. The Committee realise that in order to command success, the demand on the part of women for the Vote must be more general than has hitherto been the case. In the coming year attempts will be made to arouse the interest and stir the apathy of the women seatholders in various districts in London.

Age of Marriage The Union was asked to present the Jewish point of view in regard to the promotion of a Bill to raise the legal age of marriage, which according to an old English Statute, which has remained unchanged, is 12 years of age in the case of girls and 14 for

boys. After consultation with the Chief Rabbi, Mrs. Eichholz took part in a deputation to the Home Secretary, arranged by the National Union of Societies for Equal Citizenship, and stated on behalf of the Union, that according to Jewish Law there was nothing to prevent the Union of Jewish Women associating themselves with such a measure.

Bethnal Green Jewish Girls' Club The Association for Jewish Youth pressed for the re-establishment of this Club, which had been in abeyance for three years, and the Union has been successful in carrying out this project, with Mrs. Ernst Schiff as President, Mrs. Donald Van den Bergh as Treasurer, Miss Doris Herz as Chairman, and a very energetic Committee.

Union of Jewish Women's Homes Association, Ltd. This scheme has been further advanced, and under the title of the Union of Jewish Women's Homes Association, Ltd., is affiliated to the United Women's Homes Association, Ltd., and is registered as a Public Utility Society. A building is being constructed on a very favourable site in Petherton Road, Highbury, consisting of sixteen single and three double-roomed Flatlets, with labour-saving devices, to be let at moderate rentals. There have been various unavoidable delays but it is now confidently hoped that the building will be completed and ready for occupation by the middle of March. Financial assistance for carrying out the scheme has been secured, partly by donations, partly by investment in the Shares of the Society, and for this the Union is greatly indebted to its members and friends. Members of the Committee have inspected the building in course of construction and report that it is substantially built and the rooms are of good size and well planned, so that the accommodation promises to be most comfortable. It is hoped in the next Report to state that the Flatlets are in full occupation.

The National Council of Women Conference was held in York from the 15th to the 19th October. Mrs. Tanburn, Miss Halford and Miss Van Noorden attended as delegates from the Union. Though no matters of special interest to Jewesses were discussed, the Meetings were full of interest on general questions pertaining to the

welfare and status of women and much useful information was gathered.

Junior Branch The Junior Branch has almost concluded its fourth year. Miss Herz has resumed the Chairmanship of the Branch, and Miss Glover has been appointed Treasurer. Many new activities have been started, including Language and Dramatic Groups, Monthly Meetings, and visits to Institutions. The "Bluebird" Concert Party, under the able direction of Mrs. Leo Sharp and Mr. José Lazarus, has had a very successful season, and given a number of concerts in different parts of London, including a performance in aid of the Stepney Country Holiday Fund. The Junior Branch has received many applications for social workers and has been instrumental in supplying various needs. The Branch is at present organising a Bazaar, in aid of the Philanthropic work of the Union, which will be held on December 11th, at 27, Arkwright Road, by kind permission of Mrs. Albert Goldberg. It is felt that there must be many members of the Union whose daughters may be interested in the work of the Junior Branch; the subscription is 2s. 6d. per annum; and the Hon. Secretaries will be very pleased to communicate with any members wishing to join.

Finance The finances of the Union are on the whole somewhat more satisfactory than they have been for the past few years. Owing to the receipt of two legacies of £50 each, left respectively by the late Mrs. A. Q. Henriques and Mrs. Henry Van den Bergh, it has been possible to wipe out the deficit with which the year commenced and to cover the current expenses. It is, however, unsatisfactory to use legacies for current expenditure, and although the Treasurer had no alternative in 1928, she hopes that the income next year will be sufficiently large to make it possible to invest these amounts.

The Union welcomes a large number of new members, but the total amount received in subscriptions is still insufficient to enable the work to be carried out efficiently and it is, therefore, hoped that a further effort will be made next year to increase still more the number of annual subscribers, as this forms the most satisfactory basis for the finances of any public organisation. If Members would assist in obtaining further support by enrolling new members or even by sending

in the names of ladies who might be approached from the Office, this result would be achieved. There are many who still do not realise the work which the Union is doing and it is for the existing members to bring this work to the notice of their friends.

The expenditure has been very carefully supervised and the greatest economy in administration compatible with efficiency has been exercised to enable the Union to keep within the bounds of its financial resources.

Thanks Thanks are due to Mr. A. H. Levy, and Dr. Mandel for their great kindness to patients referred to them for treatment. To the Hon. Solicitor, Major H. L. Nathan, very especial thanks must be offered for all the work he has undertaken in respect of the Housing Scheme and the Articles of Association. The occasions for seeking his advice and help are so frequent that the grateful statement here made is but a poor expression of the Union's sense of indebtedness.

Sheffield Branch The Committee would also like to place on record their grateful appreciation of the efforts of Mrs. H. Stone, the Hon. Organiser in Sheffield. It is entirely owing to her energies that such an active and flourishing Branch of the Union exists in that city, and her list of paying members makes Sheffield rank as the Union's largest provincial Branch.

Thanks for Gifts and Necessitous Ladies' Fund The Committee desire to offer thanks to their friends and to the various charitable Societies for gifts in kind; notably the Queen Mary's London Needlework Guild, the Society for the distribution of Bread, Meat and Coal Tickets, the Grocery Relief Fund; the Passover Relief Fund. Theatre and concert tickets, clothing and furniture, and a special gift of a bed and bedding for an invalid have been received from private sources, for which the gratitude of the Committee and that of the beneficiaries is here recorded. There are many occasions on which help may be offered to those ladies, who living in straitened circumstances bear their misfortunes with fortitude and never voice their needs aloud. It is the privilege of the Union of Jewish Women to be in touch with a number of these women living on very limited means, to whom they are able to offer a small measure of comfort, either

through the very valuable Hahn Bequest, which allows of some financial assistance, or through the kindness of friends who have become interested in this branch of the Union's activities. Thus holidays have been provided for the weak and weary, grants made to secure service for the aged and infirm, or for those suffering from temporary illness, and contributory payments made to secure dentures or surgical appliances. The Hahn Fund and contributions by other generous donors constitute an emergency fund providing for the most varied needs, and it is applied with every consideration for an exceedingly sensitive type of recipient.

UNION OF JEWISH WOMEN'S LOAN FUND.

The Loan Fund has during the last year, as since it was granted to the Union in 1906, proved of the greatest benefit to young girls and women wishing to train for a professional career. At the present time there are twenty-six trainees on the register. Eleven have completed their course of studies and are in good posts: they repay regularly by instalments. Eleven are still training for the various vocations they intend to follow. Four are being assisted with maintenance while studying, thus being enabled to continue to train. During the year two girls who trained for medicine have completed their course of studies, and are both now in good posts. Several girls are training as teachers of special subjects with every prospect of remunerative work when their studies are finished.

Dispensing, Domestic Economy teaching, and Secretarial work have attracted other trainees; but the Union regrets that no one has applied for assistance to train as a Nurse or Matron. Both of these types of trained women are urgently needed for our Institutions, and the Union would welcome any suitable candidate for either of these careers so suited to women.

During the year two trainees have completed and repaid their indebtedness to the Union. Three additional grants have been made and five new loans have been given.

The sums granted amount to £252 6s. 8d., and repayments

to £200 7s. We would remind our members that the fact that no bad debts have been incurred, clearly shows how successful our trainees are and the care that is taken in advising a career which is likely to prove successful.

The Loan Fund is designed to assist the educated girl to train for some professional career; it is granted without interest, and repayments are only due when training is completed and a good post obtained. The Union seeks to obtain the latest information as to suitable and new careers open to women. The Secretary is always to be seen at the Office by appointment and is ever ready to assist with advice, or information anyone applying to her for such help. All interviews are given in private, and every effort made to avoid advising a career which might prove to be overcrowded, or likely to become so.

Before leaving the Loan Fund's yearly review, the Union once again wishes to place on record its gratitude to Mrs. Hoster, who has given one of her valuable Scholarships to a suitable candidate recommended by the Committee and of whom she approves. It should be noted that this generous training is only given to girls who have matriculated or had higher education.
