Dear Miss Phillips,

I am instructed by my Executive Committee to forward to you the following resolutions for inclusion in the Agenda of the Council Meeting of the National Union of Women's Suffrage Societies on March the 19th.

Alteration of Rule V.

To add at the end of Clause 1 :- "Provided always that in order to avoid the plural representation of the aforesaid not more than one Society be admitted to the Union from any such area."

Resolution I.

That in the opinion of this Council it is ~~meet~~ desirable that National Union speakers should appear upon the platforms of Candidates who are in favour of Women's Suffrage.

Resolution II.

That in the opinion of this Council, it is desirable that the Societies take into consideration whether the conditions in their constituencies are favourable to running a suitable Woman Suffrage candidate, and report to the Executive Committee of the National Union of Women's Suffrage Societies.
