Catherine Breschkovskiy - called "fiendmother
of the Russian Revolutionary Movement" -
born 1848 - reported killed in Russia in
1918.

She was a most moving simple speaker against
Czarism - arrested & imprisoned then sent to
Siberia in 1874 - in 1881 she escaped - caught
sent to five years in Penal Servitude in Siberia.
1890 timed propaganda - Russia - then U.S.A.
Took part in Terrorist-movement - having been
convinced that without free institutions there
was no alternative.

Wonderful organizer, inspired multitudes with ideal
of free Russia.

Arrested again in 1908 - betrayed by Arzef -
again sent to Siberia - Kerensky recalled
her in
