The Branch Clinics show an increase of 120 per cent in new patients and over 400 in return visits. These clinics are now satisfactorily established in good premises and there is an insistent demand for expansion, which it is the earnest desire of the Committee to meet. Plans have been made with the various Borough Councils concerned for the opening of gynæcological sessions and the gradual development of the work on the lines of the great expansion at Telford Road during the last few years. The Committee were budgetting during the whole of the year under review for this strengthening of the Branch Clinics, and it was their intention to devote the savings of the previous two or three years to this purpose. It will be seen from the balance-

sheet that during 1938-1939 no saving was effected. How far these plans can be carried out—and it is of little use to start on them unless they can be maintained—in war-time conditions, will depend largely on the continuance of help and support from all friends and subscribers.

It is clear that the Birth Control service at Telford Road has reached "saturation point", and that the thirteen to fourteen-hundred new patients is a rough limit set by the considerations of locality and accessibility. The gynæcological work however is still growing, though more slowly than the original work of Birth Control. Hardworking women are less able to recognise the need for gynæcological treatment than they are to demand the knowledge by which they can space births to suit their physical and economic resources.

The closest co-operation has been maintained throughout the year with the Kensington Public Health Authorities, who have invited the Clinic to open a special session in Westbourne Grove for patients referred from Borough Council Welfare Centres.

Talks to women and girls have continued very satisfactorily and there has been a steadily increased demand for these from clubs, Women's Co-operative Guilds, Y.W.C.A. branches, &c. There was a total of 65 given during the year, of which 42 were given by doctors.

In March Miss Mocatta, M.D., F.R.C.S., was appointed medical registrar of the Clinic, on the recommendation of the Medical Committee. By a careful analysis of Clinic records, their statistical value can be utilized for scientific purposes.

The Annual Meeting was again held at the Clinic and was addressed by Dr. C. P. Blacker, M.C., M.A., F.R.C.P., General Secretary of the Eugenic Society, on the inter-relation of Population Problems and Eugenic Birth-Control work.
