Order: Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children (Amendment)

A m. kir. kereskedelemügyi miniszternek 1933. évi 33.469 számú rendelete. A téglaverésnél foglalkoztatott fiatalkorúak és nők részére tizenegy órai éjjeli pihenő-idő biztositása. 1933. évi junius hó 2-én. (Belügyi Kozlöny, 1933. évi június 18., 26. szám.)

Order no. 33,469/1933 of the Minister of Commerce, to provide for a nightly rest period of eleven hours for young persons and women employed in brickmaking. Dated 2nd June, 1933.

I hereby repeal section 33 of Order no. 150,443/1930¹ issued by one of my predecessors on 30th December, 1930, respecting the administration of certain provisions of Act no. V of 1928² respecting the protection of children, young persons and women employed in industry and in certain other undertakings, which section provided for an exception to the general rule with respect to the employment of young persons and women engaged in brickmaking by hand and the stacking of bricks, and made it possible for their nightly rest period to be reduced to less than eleven hours. In consequence of this provision, young persons and women employed in brickworks shall be granted an uninterrupted nightly rest period of eleven hours, including the period from 10 p. m. to 5 a. m., in conformity with section 12 of Act no. V of 1928² and section 8 of the above-mentioned Order¹ of my predecessor.

This Order shall come into operation on 1st September, 1933.
